## MARKET MOVEMENTS RETROACTIVE

### STOCK PRICES PROVE UNREADY TO FOLLOW ADVANCES OF THE DAY BEFORE.

New York, Feb. 16.—The stock market today proved itself unready to follow the advance of yesterday and thus disappointed the hopes of the speculative element. The latter hours of the session today saw conditions as stagnant as at any time last week. The foreign market led the way. As the London situation was largely influenced in shaping speculation yesterday in New York the contrary movement there today was of important sympathetic effect. News

was received that the trust companies in this city were sending out notices to depositors of the interest paid on deposits. The rate of interest paid by these institutions on different classes of deposits has ranged from 3 to 4 per cent, and has served as a potent factor to draw in deposits from all over the country. With the prevailing rates for money and the additional reserve requirements up to 15 per cent of deposits, which was imposed on the trust companies on Feb. 1, they find themselves unable to use these funds on terms that will reimburse them for such high rates to the depositors. The supply of new issues of bonds continues very large. The market had under discussion today a \$70,000,000 Austrian loan, an Irish land purchase loan, a New York city \$10,000,000 corporate stock issue and a coming Burlington bond issue of probably \$20,000,000 or upward. Whether on account of these large prospective requirements or from mere sympathy with the tone of the market the bond division today was inclined to drop. The heaviness

of the Erie issues had some influence on this result. The illness of the president of the American Smelting & Refining company militated against its stock and with some sympathetic effort elsewhere. Bonds were heavy. Total sales, par value, \$5,890,000. United States 2s registered declined 1/4 and the coupons advanced 1/4 per cent on call today. New York Closing Stocks.
