

SEVERE HAIL STORM CAUSES MUCH DAMAGE

El Paso, Texas, June 21.—Passengers arriving here today over the Mexican Central railroad report that a devastating hail storm passed over the country around Elmerita station, near Chihuahua, on Saturday. Vegetation was laid flat by the pelting hail. On the ranch of General Luis Terrazans, near Elmerita, it is estimated that all but two sheep out of a flock of 2,000 were killed by the storm. Hundreds of carcasses were piled along the railroad tracks.

PASSENGERS COLLIDE.

Mount Carmel, Ill., June 21.—A head-on collision occurred just west of here today between two southern railway passenger trains. The accident was caused by an error in train orders. Mail Clerk Jackson was killed. Both engineers were seriously injured and several passengers received slight injuries.
