PROCTOR RESIDENTS FIGHT DIVISION

PEOPLE OF "OLD DAYTON" ON FLATHEAD RESERVATION ARE UP IN ARMS.

Kalispell, Jan. 12.—(Special).—The first move in the battle of "old Flatheads" to thwart the division of Flathead county by the slicing off, along with the reservation, a portion of the tax-paying property in this county, has been made by the sending of letters to legislators and by the circulation of a petition signed by 50 names of residents at Proctor asking that the line proposed by Polson boomer, including six townships near Proctor, of timber land and orchards, be run on the old reservation line, if the division is made at all. The land thus proposed to be taken into the new county is now tributary to Kalispell by good roads, and it is claimed by C. E. Proctor, who is fighting the case and circulating petitions, that the new county, without property from which to draw sustenance and with vast improvements to make, would never provide the necessary wagon roads from Proctor to Polson. He declares that Proctor has "been through all that for 20 years" and is now ready to enjoy the fruits of connection with an old settled community, and does not wish to go in for any more pioneering.
