

# LEAD-SILVER ORE IN STAR MINE IS FOUND

FEDERAL MINING COMPANY IS  
DEVELOPING THROUGH  
MORNING TUNNEL.

Mullan, Nov. 7.—(Special).—According to reports the Federal company has opened a large body of lead-silver ore in the Star property through the Morning No. 5 tunnel. The ore is said to be of excellent grade. The company has been driving the No. 5 level for the past year with machine drills to open the Star ground at great depth. The property was bonded from the Finch & Campbell interests, E. H. Moffett of Wallace, Clarence Cunningham of Alaska coal land fame and others. It consists of a group of claims directly west of the company's Morning group, and is on the same vein system. The strike is of great importance to the Mullan district in particular. The mine will be worked through the Federal No. 6 tunnel and the ore milled in the Morning plant.

Reliable reports from the Iron Mountain mine at Superior, Mont., are to the effect that recent development work in the mine has opened a new rich and extensive body of lead-silver ore. The company now has its milling plant nearly remodeled, and expects to again resume milling operations by the first of the coming year. The main working shaft is being put down an additional 100 feet.

The Federal company at Mullan is laying a pipe line from the Morning mill to pick up the waters of Gold creek and several large springs in that vicinity. The water will be used for domestic purposes and for fire protection. The company has built about 5,000 feet of flume line on Gold creek to convey the water to a central tank.

The Carbon Hill company in the Mullan district is now installing a new water power plant to operate their air compressor, which has been operated by a gas engine. As soon as the new plant is installed it is the intention of the company to sink on the galena strike recently made in the tunnel, which consists of 12 or 14 inches of high grade lead-silver and zinc ore. The property is located near the "S" bridge, east of Mullan, on the south side of the mineral belt.

The Reindeer-Queen company, the new consolidation of the Reindeer and Copper-Queen companies in the Mullan district, has a crew of eight men employed placing the property in shape for active operations, which will be conducted through the lower tunnel on the Reindeer claim. The tunnel was found backed full of water on account of a cave, and most of the buildings were crushed by last winter's snow. This damage has now all been repaired and everything placed in good shape for this winter's operations. The company will start driving on the vein east to reach the big cropping of copper ore on the Copper Queen claim. The work will be in ore from the start, and is expected to make an excellent showing by the time it reaches a point under the upper workings of the Copper Queen. Some of the best copper ore ever taken from the south side came from this claim, while several carloads have been shipped from the Reindeer.

The National company expects to start its new copper mill at Mullan by the first of the year. The building is now all under cover and the machinery is being placed in position as fast as it arrives. The tramway for the electric line from mine to mill is all under cover and ready for operation. At the mine the work of setting the new 30-inch compressor plant is about completed, and the raise in the mine has advanced to within 300 feet of completion. The process to be used in the mill will be principally a flotation method.

The Idora company has taken a bond and lease on the Tuscumbia property in the Sunset district for a period of two years for \$225,000. The property will be immediately opened through the Idora workings. Both the Idora and the Tuscumbia have proven ore bodies, and the Idora is now shipping steadily from its new milling plant. The ore is hauled to Bunn station by wagon.

Angus Sutherland returned this week from Salt Lake, where he has been engaged in developing the St. Lawrence mine, of which he is one of the owners. He shipped two cars of high grade copper ore from the property this spring, and reports the showing of ore to be excellent. The property adjoins the Richmond, from which ore shipments have been made this season.
