HISTORIC WESLEYAN BUILDING DISCARDED, WITH CEREMONY, FOR NEW HALL.

Helena, Dec. 18.—(Special).—At this morning's chapel the old College hall of the Montana Wesleyan university was formally abandoned.

For 13 years the students of Montana Wesleyan have studied and worked in College hall; for 13 years this building has stood as a monument to Christian education.

Built Thirteen Years Ago. When College hall was built 13 years ago, under the administration of Dr. Van Stry, now deceased it was then considered a model of school architecture.

Through the generosity and helpfulness of the citizens of Helena, the new student hall was made a possibility, and it stands today fully equipped and fully completed.

Last College Yell. However, it will be with some misgivings and with no little amount of feeling that the students will say good-bye to the old hall that they have learned to love and revere.

When the last strains of that song, "College Hall," faded away, every loyal student of Montana Wesleyan realized that the old building had served its usefulness and would house them no more.


