

# If You Can't Fight Put Your Pocketbook to Work


**Buy a \$4.16 War Savings Stamp--Uncle Sam will buy it back  
from you January 1, 1923, for \$5.00**

Buy it for cash, or buy it on the installment plan; 25c  
down and 25c whenever you feel like saving it.

## How to Start With 25 Cents

A Thrift Stamp costs you 25 cents. Affix it to your Thrift Card, supplied free when you buy your first Thrift Stamp.

Buy more Thrift Stamps, buy one every time you have a spare quarter. When you have 16 Thrift Stamps, \$4.00 worth, exchange it and 16 cents more for one War Savings Stamp. You will receive a War Savings Certificate with your War Savings Stamps affixed thereto. There is no charge for the certificate. Thrift Stamps will always sell for the same price, 25 cents, by law no more or no less.

## How to Start With \$4.16

You may start your War Savings Certificate by simply purchasing a War Savings Stamp and attaching it to your Certificate. The Certificate will be furnished free when you purchase your first War Savings Stamp. Purchase another one every time you have the necessary cash. The present price of War Savings Stamps is \$4.16 each. All War Savings Stamps, no matter when purchased, have the same maturity value, \$5.00 each, on January 1, 1923. For the above reason War Savings Stamps advance in price one cent a month.

On January 1, 1923, five years hence, the United States Government will pay you \$100 for each certificate containing 20 War Savings Stamps. They will have cost you \$82.40. You will receive \$17.60 for the use of your money; that is 4 per cent compounded quarterly, or a little more than 4 1-4 per cent straight interest.

A PARTLY FILLED CERTIFICATE WILL BE REDEEMED AT THE ABOVE STATED TIME PRO RATA OR A PARTLY FILLED CERTIFICATE OR A FULL CERTIFICATE WILL BE REDEEMED AT ANY TIME BY GIVING THE POSTMASTER, AT A MONEY ORDER OFFICE, 10 DAYS' NOTICE.
