CONSTITUTION

OF THE

Confederate States of America.

We, the people of the Confederate States, each State

acting in its sovereign and independent character, in

order to perpetuate the Union, to establish

justice, insure domestic tranquility, and secure

the blessing of liberty to ourselves and our poster-

ity, do ordain and establish this Constitution for the

Confederate States of America.

SECTION I.

All legislative powers herein delegated shall be vested

in a Congress of the Confederate States, which shall

consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

SECTION 2.

The House of Representatives shall be composed of

members chosen every second year by the people

of the several States, and the electors in each State

shall have the qualifications requisite for electors of the

most numerous branch of the State Legislature; but no

person shall hold office as Representative of the Confed-

erate States, who shall not have attained the age of

twenty-five years, and who shall not, when elected,

be seven years a citizen of the Confederate States, and

who shall not, when elected, be an inhabitant of that

State in which he shall be chosen.

3. Representatives and electors shall have the qualifi-

cations requisite for electors of the most numerous

branch of the State Legislature; but no person shall

hold office as Representative of the Confederate States,

who shall not have attained the age of twenty-five

years, and who shall not, when elected, be seven

years a citizen of the Confederate States, and who
