## ANTI-SALOON LEAGUE TO GO AFTER TIGERS RIGHT

Will Ask Assembly of North Carolina to Harmonize State Laws With Federal Enactments

The board of trustees of the North Carolina Anti-Saloon League in annual session in Raleigh last Thursday called on the General Assembly to make the North Carolina prohibition laws harmonize with the national enactments; and asked North Carolina Senators to resist any weakening of the Volstead Act. It also exhorted all officers from policeman to Governor to the strict enforcement of the law.

Here goes the resolution drawn up by the league:

"Resolved that the supreme temperance duty in North Carolina today is the enforcement of our existing laws, and we ask our temperance leaders to make next year 'Law Enforcement Year' and subordinate all other temperance

matters to the supreme task of getting rid of the blind tiger and blockade still in North Carolina.

"1. We should do this by calling for rigid enforcement of the law by all officials from policemen, mayors, constables, and sheriffs to judges and governor.

"2. We should do this by insisting that every church and Sunday School in the State make specific inquiry as to the prevalence of liquor-making or liquor-selling in its community and take action to eliminate such lawlessness.

"3. We should do this by teaching in public schools and Sunday schools the evil effects of alcohol on the drinker.

"4. We should do this by calling on North Carolina Senators and representatives to resist any weakening of the strong arm of the national government in its enforcement of the Eighteenth amendment.

"5. Finally we should do this by adequate publicity as to the duties of all public officials and to this end ask not only the support of all men voters, but we ask for the organized co-operation of our newly enfranchised women citizens in demanding the rigid observance of the requirement of the law as set forth in the following statute:

"Section 1. It shall be the duty of the sheriff of each county in the State and of the police of each incorporated city or town in the State, to search for and seize any distillery or apparatus used for the manufacture of intoxicating liquors in violation of the laws of North Carolina, and to deliver the same, with any materials used for making such liquors found on the premises, to the board of county commissioners, who shall confiscate the same and shall cause said distillery to be cut up and destroyed in their presence, or in the presence of a committee of said board and who may dispose of said material, including the copper or other material from the destroyed still or apparatus, in such manner as they may deem proper.

"Section 2. That it shall be the duty of said officers to seize and then and there destroy any and all liquors which may be found at such distillery, and to arrest and hold for trial all persons found on said premises engaged in distilling or aiding or abetting in the manufacture or sale of intoxicating liquors."

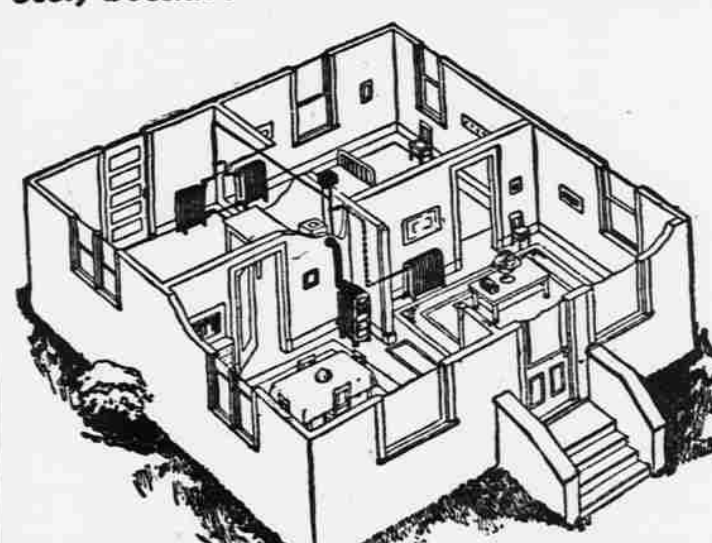

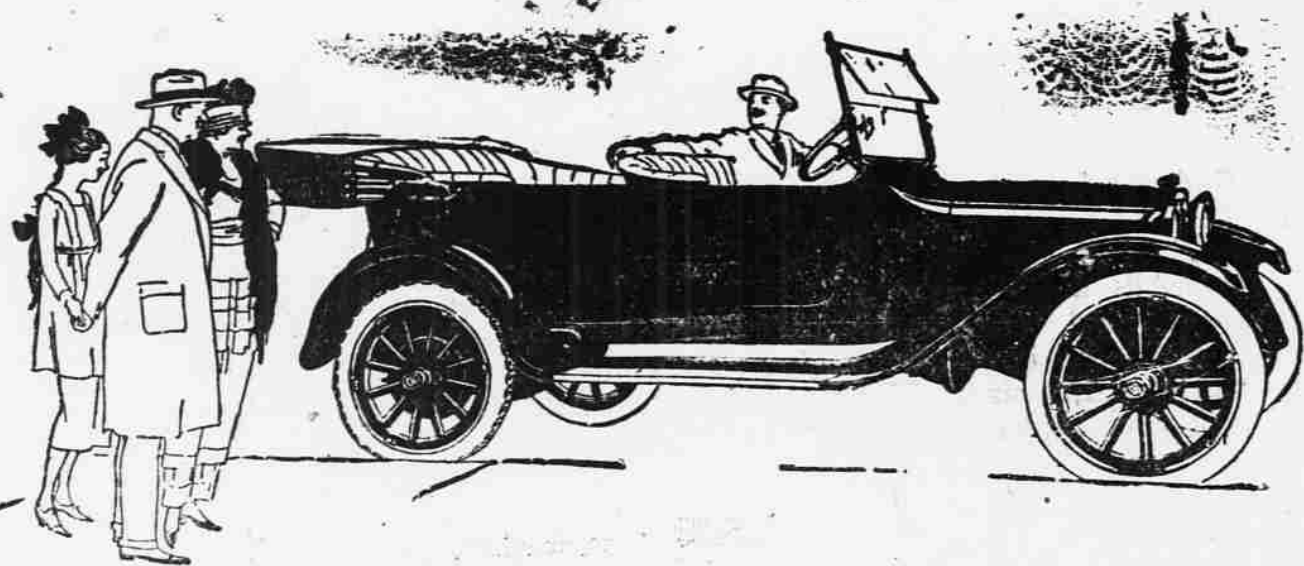
