FOURTH EDITION. LATER FROM EUROPE. The Fenian Muddle in Ireland—More Arrests—The Steamship Great Eastern to Sail for New York on Saturday, March 23—Turkey About to Favor Christians.

By the Atlantic Cable. LONDON, March 16—Noon.—Large bodies of troops have been sent to Liverpool to preserve the peace, a rising of the Irish in that city being apprehended. The 20th before stated. Large numbers of Fenians have been captured in various parts of Ireland, and many of them committed for high treason. Liverpool, March 16—Noon.—The steamer Great Eastern will sail from this port on Saturday next, the 23d inst., for New York, and not Wednesday, as the 20th before stated.

PARIS, March 16—Noon.—General Castellan, aide-de-camp of the Emperor Napoleon, who a short time ago was ordered on a special mission to the City of Mexico to confer with Marshal Bazaine and the Emperor Maximilian on Mexican affairs, has returned to Paris. LONDON, March 16—Noon.—The Servian question has been settled. Earl Derby says officially that the forces of the Sublime Porte are to leave Belgrade, and that the Servian army and that the country will be practically free. The authority of the Turks there will be merely nominal. Lord Lyons, the Ambassador of Great Britain at Constantinople, writes that Turkey will hasten the reforms in favor of the Christians in Macedonia, and that the Servian army will be received from the south and that the Turkish forces will be successful in a battle with the rebels in Bosnia.

VIENNA, March 16—Noon.—Despatches received from the south announce that the Turkish forces have been successful in a battle with the rebels in Bosnia. A MURDER IN SCHUYLKILL COUNTY. The Superintendent of a Coal Mine is Being Held in Prison on the Charge of Murdering a Workman.

THE SUPERINTENDENT OF A COAL MINE IS BEING HELD IN PRISON ON THE CHARGE OF MURDERING A WORKMAN. (SPECIAL DISPATCH TO THE EVENING TELEGRAPH.) POTTSVILLE, Pa., March 16.—Yesterday afternoon, Mr. Littlehauser, the Superintendent of a coal mine at Clencoch, about six miles from this city, was arrested on the charge of murdering the money to pay the men employed under him. As he was alone at the time, the money was not given him, but he was told to return to-day by the train for the purpose of receiving it. About 6 o'clock he started on his way home, on a horse-drawn wagon, and was accompanied by some person or persons waylaid and shot him through the head, the ball evidently producing instant death.

IT IS supposed that the murderers knew of his intention to procure the money, and thinking that he had a large amount of it, committed the deed with the view of robbing him. A revolver which he is known to have carried, was missing when the body was discovered. He leaves a wife and three children. He was about forty years of age. No clue to the guilty parties has been obtained as yet.
