

HOW GAS IS MADE IN PARIS.

Consumption of Gas in Paris—Management of a Company.

A year before the close of the last century, that is to say, in the year VII of the French Republic, one Philippe le Bon, an engineer of bridges and roads, announced to the Institute that he had discovered a mode of lighting streets and houses by gas made from coal.

On the 1st of January, 1859, these five companies were amalgamated, under the title of the "Parisian Company for Lighting and Heating by Gas," and received a concession for fifty years.

The gas is sold to the town at the rate of fifteen centimes the cubic metre, and at the rate of thirty centimes to private persons.

Gas in Paris is in fact used not only as a necessary commodity, but as a luxury, and for the enhancement of display in public places, in cafes, shops, and theatres.

Both the process by means of retorts, and that known as "coking," are made use of. The retorts produce a gas which is fit for domestic purposes, and the "coking" process gives excellent fuel for locomotives and for the use of foundries.

In the great gas works at Villette is an experimental manufactory and laboratory, where take place analyses of coal and the processes of the manufactory.

Fourteen offices are scattered over the wide district within the company's limits, where the requests and complaints of consumers are dealt with expeditiously and fairly enough.

Besides the immense extent of piping we have spoken of, the company will always undertake to put up what is called a "colonne montante," or prolongation of the street pipe, which ascends the interior of a house to the highest floor.

The Paris Gas Company is an excellent example of the success of good management and sound social economy.
