

NEWS SUMMARY.

City Affairs. The newly-appointed United States Marshal for this district, General Ely, was in the city yesterday. He expects to enter upon his duties early in the coming week. Hereafter three Reserve officers will be detailed nightly to sleep at the Central Station, so that citizens needing the services of an officer in this vicinity can always find one during the night at this station. Mayor Fox has received a series of resolutions passed by the Pennsylvania Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, praiseworthy of the conduct of the men of the police force. There have been considerable additions made to the mechanical and laboring force at our Navy Yard within the present week. The increase grew out of an order for the immediate fitting out of three monitor iron-clads, all of which are now at the yard for repairs and equipment. A final hearing in the case of Silas Fuller, charged with selling an explosive burning fluid contrary to law, was held by Alderman Beller yesterday afternoon, and the defendant was held in \$1000 bail to answer. Since Mr. Fuller's arrest, Mr. Evans has seized some seventeen barrels of the fluid at different grocery stores. In a few days the police will adopt the new uniform intended for summer use. The coat, pants, and vest will be navy blue. The head dress will consist of a pearl-colored felt hat, with black ribbon. The sergeants will be similarly dressed, but the hat will have the word "sergeant" on the front in silver letters, surrounded by a wreath in imitation of gold. The Lieutenants will wear white vests and dark blue pants and coats. The City Treasurer is now paying loans of the city maturing on the 1st of July next, out of the money belonging to the Sinking Fund; he is also paying all warrants registered in 1868, but no funds are available at the present time to pay any of the warrants registered in 1869. As no special provision was made in the ordinance directing the payment of warrants according to the date of register, in favor of school-teachers, they have to wait, with others, until the Treasurer gives notice. Yesterday morning, at 11 o'clock, a dog, supposed to be mad, ran up Third street from Race, biting and mauling at everybody in his path. The cry of mad dog was raised, and the street was soon cleared. At the Rotterdam Hotel, midway between Race and Arch, on Third street, the brute dashed into the bar-room and cleared the place, but the doors were closed and the dog confined. Officer Lamshack, of the Fourth district, went in and fired from his revolver. The first shot struck, and the mad creature was immediately killed. Yesterday morning, Roseme Detective Heilmann and Assistant Assessor Johnson paid a visit to the district of Richmond in search of illicit distilleries and contraband whisky. Back of No. 1257 Sorrell street, in a shed, they found a still in operation, and in the main premises four barrels of whisky were discovered. Not having the means to remove the still and whisky, the former was broken in a manner to render it useless, and the heads were knocked out of the whisky barrels and the spirits allowed to run into the gutter. The presence of the Revenue officers drew a crowd about the premises and in the neighborhood, and stones were thrown at them. As soon as it was discovered that the whisky was to be run into the gutter, a number of women and children hurried to the scene, provided with pitchers and other vessels, and actually scooped the liquor out of the gutter. Before the officers left, they were obliged to show their weapons to the bold and lawless "crowd." In a shed back of Salmon street, near Monmouth, a still was found in operation, which was rendered useless for whisky making. By this time the crowd had become so violent in behavior and language, that the officers did not deem it prudent to make further search for stills and whisky. Domestic Affairs. Gold closed yesterday at 133 1/2. An Indian cemetery has been exhumed in St. Louis. The shafts of the Gold Hill mines are still closed. The workwomen of St. Louis are about forming a workingwomen's union. There were 405 fires in Chicago during the last municipal year. Losses, \$560,169. Colonel William B. Stokes has taken the stump, in Tennessee, in opposition to A. J. The new commissioner of Patents will assume the duties of his position next week. The brig H. C. Colvin has been seized at New Orleans, for violation of the revenue laws. David H. Carpenter was executed at Angelica, N. Y., yesterday, for the murder of his brother. Ten thousand dollars' worth of property was destroyed by fire in Norfolk on Thursday night. The redoubtable Joseph Segar has nominated himself as a candidate at large for his beloved State of Virginia. The Legislature of Pennsylvania adjourned sine die yesterday, being the most acceptable thing it did this session. The President yesterday nominated James Pollock to be Director of the Mint in this city, and Wilmer Worthington to be Appraiser at this port. A delegation from the "Junta Patriotica," of New York, will be in this city to-day, to meet Cubans and friends of Cuba, to organize a branch Junta. Colonel John A. Campbell, the new Governor of Wyoming Territory, took the oath of office on Thursday, and is on his way to his territorial capital. Among the confirmations by the Senate yesterday were ex-Governor Curtin as Minister to Russia, Ebenezer Bassett as Minister to Hayti, and E. S. Parker as Commissioner of Indian Affairs. The President will soon issue a proclamation submitting to the people of Virginia the Constitution of that State. It is understood that the election will take place on the first Thursday in May. Foreign Affairs. FLORENCE, April 16.—A bill for the reorganization of the army is before Parliament. It gives the actual strength of the army at four hundred thousand. LONDON, April 16.—At the New Market races yesterday, the biennial stakes were won by "Blue Gown." The winner of last year's Derby, "Blue Gown," was second and Phoenix third. HAVANA, April 16.—In consequence of the appearance in New York of a document issued and signed by Morales Lemus, imposing a contribution on Cuban refugees for the support of the revolutionary cause, General Dulce has issued a proclamation ordering the seizure of all property belonging to Lemus, Leon, Casanova, Cisneros, Cisneros, and others, unless they produce necessary proofs that they have complied with the legal requirements in the transfer of their property to other parties. Havana journals generally praise this decree of confiscation. The rebel leader, Adolfo, has been captured and executed at Manzanillo. It is reported that a schooner, with a cargo of arms, had been captured near the mouth of Matanzas river, at the western end of the island, while trying to run the blockade. The hotel Ynglaterra took fire last night, and was totally destroyed. The brig S. Brown, from Nassau, for Wilmington, with guano, was wrecked on Paredon Keys, and is a total loss. The crew were saved. Sugar buoyant at 9 1/2 for No. 12 D. S. Exchange on London, 11 1/2 premium; on United States, short sight, in currency, 22 1/2 discount; 60 days, in gold, 1 1/2 premium; 2 1/2 discount. New York, April 16.—A Cuba despatch says the Mary A. Lowell has been taken to the Arsenal and is being discharged. The depositions of the crew have been sent to the British Government. Secretary Fish telegraphs to Consul Hall asking for the details of the case of the Lizzie Major. An extensive campaign has been planned in the Central Department. Troops are to march to the south side of the island, while war steamers are to cruise off the southern coast.

Nuevitas advices of the 10th say the insurgents are sanguine of capturing Holguin, which Benigno is protecting. There are 17,000 souls in the town. Benigno asks for reinforcements. LONDON, April 16.—3 A.M.—In the House of Commons to-night, Mr. Gladstone moved that the House go into committee on the bill for the re-establishment of the Irish Church. Mr. Newdegate, Conservative, moved as an amendment that the House go into committee in six months from the present day. This motion was voted against to an indefinite postponement. A lively debate followed, during which Mr. R. S. Aytoun, member for Kirkcaldy, created a sensation by declaring his objection to that clause in the bill which provided for the support of Maynooth College. Mr. Aytoun is a Liberal, and voted with the majority in the division on March 23, when the bill passed to its second reading. His declaration was followed by a scene of great excitement in the House. The opposition cheered repeatedly, and counter cheers and other interruptions came from the Ministerial benches. When Mr. Aytoun ended his remarks the confusion subsided, and the debate was continued. Most of the speeches were made by the minor members of the opposition. At the end of this discussion, which lasted six hours, Mr. Gladstone rose and said, due care would be given by the Government to the terms of the provisions made for Maynooth College. He attributed much of the opposition to the bill to the power of the clergy in Ireland. That power had been built up by the old policy of England, which has lately been partially reversed, and was now about to be finally and completely destroyed. He stated that he was not in favor of the success of this bill was not a question of party, but of justice. Mr. Disraeli followed. He disapproved of the division on Mr. Newdegate's motion for postponement, and said he was anxious to get the committee on the bill. The House divided on the original motion to go into committee, with the following result:—For, 355; against, 229. The House then formally went into committee on the bill, and adjourned. I give and bequeath to my sister, Martha C. Ware, the interest of ten thousand dollars during all the term of her natural life, in semi-annual instalments, her receipts, or those of any other party who may be properly authorized by or for her to act, to be the only sufficient vouchers for such payments, and the said interest not to be subject or liable in the hands of my executor to the control of debts, contracts, or obligations of my said sister, or of her present or future husband, with whom she may hereafter intermarry. I give and bequeath to such of the children of my deceased sister, Sarah Scott, who may survive me, the sum of ten thousand dollars, to be equally divided among them, share and share alike, and to be paid to them in semi-annual instalments during all the term of his natural life. I give and bequeath to my friend, Mrs. Susan Livermore, the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) in cash. I give and bequeath to my uncle, Thomas Caffrey, \$1000. I give and bequeath to my uncle, Samuel Caffrey, \$750 per annum, during all the term of his natural life. I give and bequeath to my aunt, Mrs. Mary Williams, \$1000. I give and bequeath to my aunt, Mrs. Rebecca Venable, \$1000. I give and bequeath to the children of my deceased brother, Charles Middleton, namely, Sarah, Harriet, and Charles, \$3000 each. I give and bequeath to my cousin, Mrs. Louisa Rambo, \$1000. I give and bequeath to my friend, Mrs. Caroline H. Lee, \$1000. I give and bequeath to my friend, Mrs. Annie Bacon, wife of Francis S. Bacon, \$10,000. I give and bequeath to my friend, Thomas Cooper, \$1000. I give and bequeath to my friend, Mrs. Eliza Stecker, \$1000. I give and bequeath to my friends, Misses Ella and Fanny Butcher, \$1000 each. I give and bequeath to my friend, Mrs. Matilda Ward, \$1000. I give and bequeath to my porter, Joseph Corson, \$1000. I give and bequeath to the Northern Home for Friendless Children, \$1000. I give and bequeath to the Magdalen Society of Philadelphia, \$1000. I give and bequeath to the Old Man's Home, \$1000. I give and bequeath to the Trustees or Managers of the private cemetery at Blackwoodtown, New Jersey, in which the remains of my mother now rest, \$1000. I give and bequeath to the Union Benevolent Association of Philadelphia, \$1000. I give and bequeath to the Presbyterian Church and the Methodist Church at Blackwoodtown, New Jersey, \$1000 each. All the residue and remainder of my estate, real, personal, and mixed, which does not hereunder otherwise dispose of, I give, devise, and bequeath to my nephew, Charles D. Middleton, his heirs and assigns forever. Lastly—I hereby nominate, constitute, and appoint the said James Otterson, Jr., and F. Carroll Brewer, executors and trustees of and under this my last will and testament.
