"Marguerite Kent," by Marion Wayne, which has just been published by J. B. Lippincott & Co., is a story in which there is less art than matter. From all its internal evidences we should pronounce it the effort of a comparatively inexperienced writer, whose enthusiasm for her subject has sometimes obscured her judgment, but in spite of its crudities it is a story of very decided merit, such as could not have proceeded from the pen of any but a writer of much ability.
