

CONDENSATIONS OF NEWS.

THE SOUTH.

Within a few days the first installment of colonists from western Massachusetts, numbering twelve families, will leave for Herk county, N. C., and begin the work of building a village about seven miles east of Morganton. The colonists have a refusal of 24,000 acres in a body, of which 19,000 is of heavy white pine timber.

Texas papers are puzzled to know how it is that pecans are sold in New York and the western market at exactly the same prices as they are in Galveston and Houston. Texas, perhaps, is laboring under the delusion that she has a monopoly of pecans, but she must remember that while her settlers were wantonly cutting down the magnificent pecan groves in the bottom lands of Texas, Louisiana and Mississippi concluded that their pecan trees were valuable, and not only preserved them but planted more, and now Texas has competition in the pecan crop.—N. O. Times.

Diphtheria continues very fatally in portions of North and South Carolina. Stonewall Jackson's daughter, Julia, says an exchange, is now a pretty girl of sixteen, with large eyes, a good head, and an expression full of sweetness and character. She is said to be exceedingly gentle, modest and thoughtful. She is living with her mother at Charlotte, N. C.

T. Markwalter, of Augusta, Ga., has been awarded the contract of building the Confederate monument at that place. His bid was \$14,490.

Augusta (Ga.) has received 113,116 bales of cotton this year.

Columbus (Ga.) has received 35,518 bales of cotton this season, a large increase over last year's receipts.

The British steamship, Student, sailed from Brunswick, Ga., the 7th, with 1,717 bales of cotton for Liverpool. It is the first direct European shipment ever made from that port, and the enthusiasm of the Brunswickers was immense.

Capt. McNelly's rangers have, in the last few months, captured or killed about seventy-five of the worst desperadoes in western Texas.

The Fort Smith (Ark.) New Era offers this novel solution to the Indian problem: Let Oklahoma be thrown open with all the right of ownership to the land secured to the legal inhabitants, and the problem is solved—for every Indian girl will marry a white man and every young Oklahoman will readily secure a white spouse, for whenever a division of land is once made every inhabitant will be, if not rich, in good circumstances. And with the restraint removed, Indians will be proud to mix with and be absorbed by the whites and become citizens of the United States, as sure as water runs down stream.

New Orleans Democrat: On Friday about noon, a duel occurred between the Hon. V. Simeon Dollanay, who was not elected administrator of water works, and Mr. Robert Torney. Bites were the weapons, and at the third exchange of shots Mr. Torney was wounded in the left breast, from the effects of which he was dying at last accounts. This is Dollanay's second duel within a year, and, as on the first occasion, upon learning that his adversary was mortally wounded, immediately fled and left his seconds to assist those of his adversary.

Among the articles found in possession of the burglars captured in Montgomery, Ala., was a gold watch belonging to Hon. F. H. Watson, Lincoln's assistant secretary of war and member of the democratic committee sent to New Orleans. Mr. Watson appeared in court Saturday and received his property, which he said cost him \$130 in London.

In Rockingham, Virginia, a young Edwards tried to forcibly take his sweetheart at church, when he received a stab from the old man that felled him to the floor and will probably end his life. He staggered up and emptied three shots, none of which took effect.

There are now seventeen murderers confined in the jail at Fort Smith, to be tried before the United States court, as their crimes were committed in the Indian territory.

Northern tramps commit half the murders and burglaries in the south.

Cotton seed oil mills are paying seven dollars per ton for seed.

Savannah News: The bronze statue that the old Palmetto guard of South Carolina are soon to erect at Charleston, in commemoration of the valor and patriotism of their regiment and of its fallen members, was successfully cast in New York to-day. The statue is of a soldier in continental uniform, carrying an old and bullet-torn flag tied to the barrel of a cannon.

Jacksonville, (Fla.) Union: It is feared that a few days of warm sunshine will develop a far greater injury to the orange groves than now appears. The tidal wave of cold seems to have traveled and extended far to the south, and great damage must have resulted from its extraordinary severity. No doubt the smaller limbs of most trees are killed, and the sap in both limbs and bodies of which the growth was not fully matured is probably so nearly disintegrated that the sun's rays will cause it to coagulate to such an extent that the trees will languish and eventually die of the injury.

Lorenzo D. Cox, of Marion county, Miss., was twice fired upon while making a fire in a clearing, and shot through both lungs. He crawled to a stump where his gun was sitting, and firing, dropped the assassin as he peered out from behind a tree. He then crawled to him and stabbed him in the heart with a knife. The would-be murderer proved to be Wm. Morris, who had come all the way from Texas to settle an old feud. Cox will not recover.

Bolzi (Ala.) Sea Coast Mirror: They are shipping on an average twenty thousand oysters per day, besides several carloads a week. This oyster trade on our coast is rapidly assuming vast proportions, and in a few years will afford employment for thousands of our people as well as profit to shippers.

Three brothers by the name of Millet have 26,000 cattle on a range one hundred and eighty miles north of Dallas. There are but few residents in the country, and though several hundred warriors, a party of United States soldiers, and a large body of Mexicans have been hunting buffalo in that locality, they have caused no trouble. Buffalo caused much trouble last year, but hunters are thinning them out.

CONGRESSIONAL.

Mrs. Walker, of Lauderdale county, Tennessee, heard a man under her bed, and taking a revolver from under her pillow, she jumped out and opened fire as only a woman can. Four buck negroes crawled out and escaped through a window.

The assessed valuation of taxable property in Texas for 1876, is \$260,000,000. The estimated deficiency in the revenues for the present year is \$800,000.

Hon. Geo. A. Trenholm, secretary of the Confederate treasury, was buried at Magnolia, S. C., Sunday. The Charleston Journal of Commerce says of him: Gen. A. Trenholm was the son of Wm. Trenholm, an English merchant. His mother was a Miss De Griffin, the daughter of a wealthy planter of St. Domingo. They fled with many others from the insurrection which swept over that unfortunate island. The subject of this notice was born in this city on the 25th of February, 1807, and had nearly reached the full age of three score years and ten. He left school at the early age of thirteen years, and then, embarking upon the sea of life, commenced that voyage through the future which, marked in its course by the most eventful incidents, yesterday reached its end.

Wytheville, (Va.) Enterprise: A wagon was driven into town Wednesday loaded with bear meat, venison, wild turkeys, pheasants, rabbits, etc. They were killed in the Stony Fork neighborhood, in this county, we learn, and belonged to different parties. Twenty cents a pound was asked for the bear meat at first, but it went off at a shilling.

Corpus Christi Gazette: A severe drought for several months has so impoverished portions of the range that cattle and horses are already beginning to show a want of nourishing food, but the animals most affected are the oxen used by Mexican teamsters from the Rio Grande to this place. They are forced to rely almost exclusively on burnt nopal, and already many of them can be seen lying dead between this point and Laredo.

Savannah News: The fruit crop of Florida has undoubtedly suffered by the severe weather. The St. Augustine Press of the second says: "Last night was the coldest for three years. Ice formed nearly an inch in thickness, killing many tender plants, and many if not all of the oranges, which were so abundant and promising. As the wind was high throughout the night, it is hoped that a portion of the crop has escaped, but we hardly think it possible." Oranges have advanced one-half cent.

The vote of Texas is as follows: The democratic electors for the state at large received 103,812 votes; republican electors, state at large, 44,552 votes. Democratic majority, 59,265. Total vote, 148,364, against a vote the last state election of 200,081.

The new Texas turf wonder, Crockett, was bought for \$40 while in the shafts of a Galveston sand-car, and driven in water two feet deep to change his pace to a trot. At the Dallas fair a western turfman offered \$12,000 for him, and at the Austin fair he made a record of 2:31, which his admirers think will be reduced to 2:20. He is on the pony order, and nothing is known of his pedigree.

In Texas all doctors are required under the new law, governing the practice of medicine, to appear before the county board of examiners, appointed by the district court, and stand an examination in chemistry, anatomy, physiology and materia medica, before they can collect their bills. Any one violating this law is liable to be indicted, fined and imprisoned.

A St. Louis dispatch says the wrecked steamers and their loss are about as follows: South Shore, \$2,000; Southern Belle, \$5,000; Fannie Keener, \$12,000; insured for \$5,000 in Cincinnati offices; Jennie Baldwin, \$8,000; Davenport, \$10,000; Rock Island, \$10,000; Bayard, \$5,000; Centennial, \$60,000. The damage to other steamers and ferryboats and the loss and damage of numerous barges and such like crafts will probably increase the total loss by the ice movement to nearly, if not quite, \$150,000.

Between ten and twenty negroes and three or four whites were wounded in New Orleans on the 15th, in a riot which grew out of the arrest of a negro deck hand who had wounded two negroes with his little pistol.

It is rumored that a compromise has been effected, under which the ring magistrates, notably Tweed and Sweeney, are to refund to the city of New York quite a large amount of money, and so receive in turn immunity in prosecution. Tweed may soon be released, and Sweeney will return from Europe. The compromise is thought to include Connelly.

Suit has been brought against the ex-prospector managers by stockholders in Philadelphia to compel a pro rata distribution of the two million dollars profits of the show.

The Americans appear to be succeeding in their plans of sending over fresh meat to this country. They have organized a system under which 8,000 quarters of fresh beef can be sent over in each steamer, not frozen, but cooled to a safe temperature by air which has passed through ice chambers. The meat is very good and "bright," and in spite of opposition from the butchers, a cargo was sold in Liverpool last week at a price of 8d a pound (12 to 16 cents). The meat, it is said, has fetched 8d per pound (16 cents) in Glasgow for some time, and does not excite the prejudice arising from the overcooked condition of the Australian tinned meat.—London Spectator.

The average speed of railroad trains from New York to the Pacific coast is nineteen miles an hour, and the San Francisco newspapers urge that it be increased to thirty, which would shorten the journey over two days.

Sonora is one of the richest mining states in Mexico. If the mines were thoroughly developed, they would excel the bonanzas of Nevada. Mining in a primitive way is being carried on by the natives, and a few foreigners are working mines owned by them. Capitalists in San Francisco have lately purchased one of the principal mines in the state for \$250,000. Sonora is also a very rich section, but unworked because of the frequent revolutionary raids.

By the committee on judiciary providing that the electors shall vote by ballot instead of by ballot, was agreed to. Mr. Merrimon gave notice of an amendment he would offer so as to make any justice of the supreme court ineligible to the appointment to any office of the United States.

In the house on the 11th, the following bills were introduced, and referred: By Mr. Ames—Reducing letter postage to two cents. To regulate compensation of letter carriers in cities of over 100,000 population at \$800 for the first year, \$900 for the second year and \$1,000 for the third year and afterwards, and making compensation in cities of less than 100,000, not less than \$800, nor more than \$900, within the discretion of the postmaster general. By Mr. Darrell—Authorizing the state of Louisiana to close such navigation by law, where it opens into the Mississippi; also to the proceeds of the sale of public lands to the education of the people. By Mr. Hunter—For the purchase of silver bullion and its coinage in the United States, and to enter for all debts, public and private, including duties and coin interest. By Mr. Cannon—To promote commerce and cheaper railroad transportation between the Atlantic seaboard and the interior of the United States by the American Midland railway. By Mr. Cramer—For protection of the states against domestic violence. It provides that the president shall employ the army and navy for such purposes as may be necessary, and that a state is certified to him that the authority of the state is forcibly resisted and is unable to overcome such resistance, or after the governor has certified to him that riot, insurrection or acts of rebellion have occurred, which such governor has endeavored and is unable to suppress, and also that he has endeavored to convene the legislature, and that such legislative act cannot be convened by reason of such domestic violence. By Mr. Kass—To establish a discriminating duty of 25 per cent on sugar, the growth or product of slave labor.
