LOOP-HOLES IN THE ELECTORAL LAW

Our Washington correspondent intimated in a dispatch published a few days ago that several loop-holes had been discovered in the Electoral law, and that if the "High Commission" continued to act in a rankly partisan manner, the Democrats might determine to avail themselves of their power to break it up.

In the first place, this act of Congress provides that the Commission which it created shall consist of fifteen members, but does not declare that a majority of the Commission shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of its business; in fact, it intentionally omitted this usual provision, in order that the supposed non-partisan character of the Commission might be preserved.

But a far more serious defect than the one we have mentioned—a defect which appears to have been the result of carelessness in the framing of the bill—is the privilege of allowing either House to take a recess until ten o'clock of the next forenoon, after an objection has been raised to the counting of the vote

of any State. Under this provision of the law either house will be able to defeat the election of a President and render a new election necessary, without taking the responsibility of contravening the letter of the law.

Before expressing any opinion as to the propriety of the course here indicated, we shall await the action of the Commission on the Louisiana case, and see whether the judges show a disposition to act with fairness and impartiality, or a settled determination to act as partisan politicians.

SENTIMENT VS. THE CONSTITUTION.

Yesterday morning's dispatches inform us that Justice Bradley considers it a great wrong that a "legal technicality" should deprive the people of Oregon of the vote of Watts, the ineligible elector.

This matter of the ineligibility of certain Republican electors, and particularly of Brewster, will probably prove the most formidable stumbling block in the way of the successful consummation of the villainous conspiracy by which it is sought to make and install a President of the United States by fraud, and we recur to it again because we know that the Electoral Commission will find it utterly impossible to count Brewster's vote without violating not only the spirit, but the very letter of the constitution and of the laws of Louisiana.

It is, perhaps, natural enough for the Republican party, at this stage of the contest, to cry out against the raising of what they are pleased to term a "legal technicality" against the counting of certain votes—a technicality which seems likely to prove fatal to their rascally schemes—but they were the first to insist upon the sanctity of the "forms of law," and, having made their bed, they must be made to lie in it.

But this ineligibility question is not a mere technicality, nor is it at all a new subject in connection with presidential elections. At almost every previous election one or more of the electors receiving a majority of the votes were disqualified by the second section of the second article of the constitution; but it so happened that in no former instance did the matter assume any practical importance, for the rejection of the votes of the ineligible electors would not have affected the general result.
