Mr. Gerry himself has done a vast amount of lobbying of a low order. He has pulled all the wires he could reach to induce members of the Assembly to withdraw their support of the bill.

For instance, he got Police Justice White to summon Assemblyman Geo. P. Roessch before him and try to switch him off from his energetic championship of this bill. But Mr. Roessch, who is made of sturdy stuff, didn't "switch." Mr. Gerry then had President Hoguet, of the Emigrant Savings Bank, attempt the same feat. But still Mr. Roessch stood by his convictions. And he will continue there, as any one who knows him can readily infer.

This is but one sample of the hocus-pocus Mr. Gerry is engineering. His method is to throw dust in the public's eyes, to appeal to prejudice, to misrepresent the bill even to the institutions affected by it, to pull wires everywhere and to lobby at all times.

On the other hand, the work of THE EVENING WORLD has been in every instance and down to the minutest detail clear and above board. We invite investigation on this score.

THE VOICE OF TAMMANY HALL.

WHEREAS, The relations of parent and child are among the most sacred of human ties, and the right of appeal is a fundamental right of the American citizen, rich and poor; and

WHEREAS, This right of appeal, granted even to criminals of every degree, is denied to parents and innocent children by the existing law; and

WHEREAS, Many cases of grievous injustice, without any legal remedy whatever, have arisen under the existing law, whereby parents have been unjustly deprived of their children and families needlessly broken up; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, That we favor the enactment of the bill now pending before the Legislature of this State amending the Penal Code so as to give courts of record power to review by certiorari, and to affirm or reverse judgments of children under the provisions of section 811 of said code, and we urge upon our representatives in the Legislature to vote for and support such an amendment.

COUNTY DEMOCRACY'S INDORSEMENT.

At the meeting of the General Committee of the County Democracy at Cooper Union March 10 the following was adopted: RESOLVED, That we recommend to the Legislature the enactment of such a law as will give the Courts the right to review the facts of the commitment of any minor by a Police Justice.

HELD IN \$5,000 BAIL.

The Alleged Dynamiters Arraigned in Court To-Day.

Brewer Stevenson's Explanation of the Explosion.

Who is the Dynamite Expert Who Prepared the Bomb?

If those men are guilty I will spend every cent I own, if necessary, to convict them. I will show conspirators that they cannot attempt to destroy my property with dynamite or anything else and go unpunished. Even if my life should pay the forfeit I will show those fiends no mercy.

Earnestly, and with difficulty, as he is suffering from a sore throat, David Stevenson, the ale brewer, spoke as above to an EVENING WORLD reporter this morning.

He was lying on a lounge in his handsome brown-stone residence at 7 East Twenty-sixth street when the reporter saw him.

He is too ill to leave the house. The men he referred to are Thomas Beardon, Clerk of No. 201 West Forty-sixth street; Patrick R. O'Connell, of No. 11 East Forty-first street, and John O'Connell, of No. 317 Bergen street.

They are members of Local Assembly No. 8, 8th District, and also of the Knights of Labor, and also belong to the Ale and Porter Brewing Protective Association.

Mr. Stevenson said that he had exploded a dynamite bomb on the Fourth street side of Mr. Stevenson's brewery about dusk on the evening of Feb. 11.

The shock was terrific. Glass was blown out of windows in houses for a block around, and several persons were slightly injured.

The police began an investigation at once. They found no trace of the explosive. Mr. Stevenson put the case in the hands of Inspector Byrne, the brewer was on the best of terms with the Ale and Porter Brewing Protective Association, which had been boycotted by Mr. Stevenson's ale.

He would employ non-union men when he saw fit to do so. He suspects that it was members of this Association who had made the attempt to blow up his brewery.

Inspector Byrne detailed Detective Valley, Evanho, Gov. Gerichon and Hanley to run down the gang parties if possible.
