KEEP IT STRAIGHT.

Nothing worse can be said of the development in the Rapid Transit scheme than that Section 23 should have struck in the bill which was passed by the Legislature.

This, however, is not necessarily bad, and if any evil comes from it it can be traced to its source.

The great point in the business now is that the Commissioners of Rapid Transit shall be what their position demands. There is no doubt as to what the people want in this matter. The Commissioners must try to give it to them, and to be as straight as a string.

Energy, clear-headedness and absolute fidelity to the trust which has been put into their hands are the qualities which should mark the Commissioners of Rapid Transit.

With the best of good will and the greatest purity of intention it is still possible for them to make mistakes. Possible, but not likely, if they proceed with patient and careful study of plans.

Let them be untiring and faithful. It is not too much to ask of them, but it will be a grateful thing just the same to the people. Keep the matter before the public. Anything that is done should be published that the Commissioners may be known to be constant at their work. Above all things, let every suspicion of partisan feeling or corruption be made impossible by the visible evidence of upright earnest work.
