SIXTH AVE. & 23D ST. SWEEPED OUT BY THE FLOOD. Bursting Oil Tanks Completely Wreck a House.

A gang of men were busy at the National Cotton Oil Company's works at Guttenberg, this morning, clearing away the wreckage caused by the bursting of two immense oil tanks.

The neighborhood of the works looked as though there had been an earthquake. The tanks were located about two thousand feet from the North River, on the side of the hill, at an elevation of 75 feet.

Between the tanks and the river are the oil works, a spur of the West Shore Railroad, along which extends a stone wall fifteen feet high, a two-story house, a stable and a tool-house.

The tank nearest the tracks was a new one and was filled with water yesterday afternoon to test its strength. It was 23 feet in diameter and 40 feet high. To the north, was a tank filled with 4,500 barrels of cotton seed oil.

The water was not in the new tank at 3:50, when the steel plates parted. The immense volume of water emptied itself upon the tank filled with oil. The tank also gave way and the contents of the two swept down the hill with a roar.

The tankhouse was wrecked in a twinkling, as was the stable.
