DOESN'T CARE A SNAP FOR 'EM.

But Goldsmith Says He'll Fight the Produce Exchange People.

Mayer Goldsmith, the millionaire stockyard owner and cattle exporter, was suspended from the privileges of membership by the Board of Managers of the Produce Exchange yesterday, snaps his fingers at his expulsion, or, at least in those who brought about his suspension, and says he is not to be bulldozed by any such tactics.

It was charged by Charles P. Sumner & Co., steamship owners and agents, of 5 Beaver street, that Mr. Goldsmith had made a verbal agreement to engage for several hundred head of cattle which he afterwards repudiated.

When Mr. Goldsmith was brought up before the Complaint Committee at the Produce Exchange he refused to submit the matter for arbitration, and his broker, Mr. Smull, refused to testify, for which contemptuous conduct the Board of Managers has suspended him.

\$5,000 FOR THROWING VITRIOL.

Policeman Carroll Sued by Suffering Watchman Fisher.

The Officer Says It Was Accidental and Not Malignant.

Policeman Michael Carroll, of the Sanitary Squad, is being sued by Joseph Fisher, a watchman, for \$5,000 damages for having thrown vitriol over him, destroying his clothing and inflicting severe burns.

Officer Carroll is one of the policemen on the staff of Dr. Martin, of the Health Board, and has been detailed to look after the final dock at the foot of Forty-fifth street, East River, and also the piers on the river front from Forty-fourth to Forty-fifth street.

An Evening World reporter had an unsuccessful search for Officer Carroll this morning at Sanitary Headquarters, along the docks of which he has charge, and at his home, 318 West One Hundred and Forty-first street.

His wife, however, said she was familiar with the story, which had been told her by her husband. She said: "Fisher is a man who hangs about the dock at Forty-fifth street and East River."

"This is one of the piers where the offal from the slaughter-houses is dumped, and requires the constant attention of the Sanitary Squad," she said.

"My husband says that Fisher does nothing for a living beyond finding from the dock and what he can catch."

"On July 12 my husband went down, as this is his custom every day, to the dock with some companions, and when requested to leave by Fisher, who was lying on the dock, my husband refused and became abusive."

"My husband had a bottle of vitriol which he was using to clean up the dock, and he threw it over the dock, and it fell on Fisher's head, and he was severely injured."

"Fisher declares that Officer Carroll's act in throwing the vitriol over him was an accident, but that he was using it for a purpose."
