### THE PERILS PAST

But Brooklyn Is Still on Short Rations of Water.

men being taken to the scene by special trains, wagons driven at breakneck speed as the houses were being evacuated.

At 6 o'clock news was sent to Police Headquarters that householders should be notified immediately to open the stopcocks so as to allow the air to escape, in anticipation of the return of water.

Half an hour later word was sent that the pumps in the Ridgewood station would be started before 8 o'clock.

It was a race against time all day at the broken conduit. Fully 300 men were at work shoveling out the sand that had crushed in the ground.

With the aid of steam derricks the great mass of sand was lifted out of the breach, and at 8 o'clock last night the entire length of the broken part of the conduit was cleared.

There was then about two inches of water in the conduit. An Italian laborer went down into the conduit, and with his shovel removed the sand in amount of sand still remaining, and at exactly 11 o'clock the water began to flow, and the long confined water burst in just as it flowed through the uncovered part of the conduit.

WATER TURNED INTO THE CONDUIT.

At 8:30 o'clock Chief Engineer Van Buren and Assistant Chief Engineer Bergen decided that the conduit was in a condition to receive the water from Spring Creek and Baisley Lake and that at those places were opened.

The slides of the conduit had been so much injured but it was considered safe to let the water flow through it, and at 11 o'clock all the pumps at the Ridgewood station were at work and the two city reservoirs were being filled.

It now remains to repair the broken conduit, but it will not be a difficult job, as barring another accident Brooklyn can begin using water to-night without stinting.

Many districts in Brooklyn were in darkness for a part of last night, as the Citizens' Electric Light Company's plant, which supplies its water here, was damaged, and consequently such districts as were for several hours cut out of the circuit.

### SHORT OF WATER AT FIRES.

### Flames Destroy Over \$100,000 Worth of Brooklyn Property.

Flames were still blazing at 10 o'clock this morning in the great double building at 202 and 204 Court street, Brooklyn, which caught fire last night, and at one time threatened a general conflagration in that part of the city.

Owing to the failure of the water supply the firemen were almost powerless at first, and the fire gained such headway that when two streams were finally brought from the fire-boat Ste. Low, away down in the East River, it was found impossible to save the building.

The two adjoining buildings at 200 and 202 Court street, were also attacked by the flames, and were saved from total destruction with difficulty and only after much damage had been done.

The blaze from the burning building lighted up the southern part of Brooklyn, and people in the neighborhood turned out of bed in the early morning hours to watch the fight being made by the firemen.

Many families residing in the immediate vicinity were panic-stricken when it was learned that the scarcity of water had so greatly interfered with the work of the firemen that they were hardly attempting to save the building.

While the big blaze on Court street was in progress another fire broke out about 1 o'clock in a four-story tenement-house at 63 Union street, only a few blocks away.

The same difficulty in obtaining water was met with here, and the building was entirely destroyed. A number of families were displaced.

The Court street fire started in E. Nielson's cigar-store in 284, and rapidly spread to the adjoining grocery store of Niel Clifford on the ground floor of 202.

The entire upper part of the double building, comprising three floors, was stored with furniture and other inflammable material, owned by Peter W. Schmidt, 302 Chamberland street.

It is believed the flames reached this part of the building that they became absolutely uncontrollable. The building was an un-occupied tenement, and was the center of the block about two hundred feet.

The whole of this space became a raging mass of flames, which shot upward a hundred feet or more into the air, carrying with them clouds of burning sparks and cinders.

The heaviest damage was done for a time, and it was this alone which saved the row of dwelling-houses which closely adjoined the burning building.

This morning there was a big wide gap extending clear through the block, and the residents of the neighborhood realized what a narrow escape they had.

The loss to the owner of the building is estimated at \$50,000. Nielson's loss is \$1,000 and Clifford's \$10,000. The damage to the building at 202 Court street, owned by John H. Johnson, is estimated at \$100,000. The loss to the owners, Samuel E. Shaw, of New York, loss \$10,000, and Jacob Endris, who had a restaurant on the ground floor is estimated at \$5,000.

The tenants in the building at 63 Union street, who were burned out, were Victor C. George, George Lurge, Franco La Rosa, Peter Maglain and Tursi Constanta. The damage there is estimated at \$20,000.

Fireman Richard Trapp, of Engine No. 2, was killed in the rear of a building at 260 Court street, all the way down to the street, and badly bruised about the body. He was taken to his mother's home, 109 Summit street.

### WON'T PAY BATES'S POLICIES.

### Two Insurance Companies Make Contest with His Heirs.

Two life insurance companies, the Mutual Life and the American Colonial, announced that they shall resist the payment of the policies written by those companies on the life of Levi M. Bates, who was drowned at Bowery Bay Oct. 10.

Mr. Bates had taken life policies in different companies, aggregating \$174,000. Of these the Equitable and the Hartford Travelers' have already paid \$25,000 each, making no contest. Other companies, except the two named above, have intimated that prompt settlements will be made.

The Mutual Life claims that its agent received for the premium on its policy a note instead of cash, and that the policy did not run unless cash payment was made. The Casualty Company does not state its ground for resisting payment.
