

FLORENCE WILL CASE ENDED.

Statement in Court that a Later Will Has Been Found.

Inspector Conlin So Testifies, but the Facts Are Disputed.

The much-talked-of codicil to the will of the late Actor Florence which his brother, Edward B. Conlin, who is contesting the will, says is in existence, cannot be proved.

Conlin declared that his brother told that the codicil would be found among his papers in his strong box. Lawyer Feitreich promptly offered to permit Conlin to examine the strong box, and on last Saturday the examination was made in the presence of the lawyers, the widow and Police Inspector Conlin.

The Inspector took the stand when the hearing was resumed this morning before E. F. Underhill, Surrogate Hanson's assistant. He testified that he had examined the private papers of his deceased brother and that the codicil was not found among them.

He did find an envelope dated May 11, 1882, and marked "last will and testament of Mr. and Mrs. Florence," which he offered for probate.

Mr. Feitreich declined to comply with the demand on the ground that one of the wills was that of a wing person. The widow, Conlin's attorney wanted a postponement to produce more evidence. Mr. Underhill refused to know the nature of the evidence.

"So far you haven't made out a case," he said. "The contestant claims that when the will was opened a paper was abstracted that is not now here. The fact that it was opened in the absence of the next of kin is in itself suspicious," exclaimed excitedly the claimant's counsel, Mr. Reynert.

"I counsel will give me his word that he has a living witness to sustain his position I will consent to any reasonable adjournment," said Mr. Feitreich.

Mr. Reynert replied that he would produce Mr. Vias of the Fifth Avenue Hotel, who had the will locked in his safe, to relate certain conversations he had with Mrs. Florence.

Mr. Reynert then said: "I give notice that I will call on you to have to offer the case is closed," said Mr. Underhill.

Surrogate Hanson, who is in Florida, will decide on his return whether the will will be probated or not.

It is the reason why Mr. Underhill took no cognizance of the alleged later will was because of evidence of its existence was offered.

Lawyer Feitreich denied to an Evening World reporter that he had any knowledge of the alleged later will.

Nothing else. One of these wills was the one offered for probate, the other is Mrs. Florence's private property and I refused to produce it.

Mr. Florence, like a careful man, placed in the envelope a date, and marked the date on it. That's all the ground there is for the talk of a second will.

Mr. Feitreich, on the other hand, was just as positive that the envelope contained a later will and the alleged codicil making Edward B. Conlin a beneficiary.

Inspector Jarvis is the man who in 1882 secured the codicil from the late Mrs. Florence for carrying dynamite into England.

His landlady, Mrs. Leonard, with whom he lived at the time, was frequently recounted to her secrets in the pursuit of dynamites.

Mr. Cullen became interested in politics early in life and has always been a member of the Assembly, and from 1871 to 1881 he served as Public Administrator of Brooklyn.

He was a trustee of the People's Trust Company, of Brooklyn, and a director in the Brooklyn Heights Railroad Company. For many years he had been the counsel of the Brooklyn City Railway.

His wife, the late Alexander McCue, was for many years a judge of the Brooklyn City Railway, and was also a member of the Cleveland and the appointment of solicitor of the Treasury.

The funeral was performed on Mr. Cullen two weeks ago to relieve him of an intestinal tumor. The operation failed.

SCORCHED BY FLAMING JUTE. CHOKED BY A TOY BAGPIPE.

Several Persons Injured in a Jersey City Factory Fire.

A shaft in a picking machine in the United States Carpet Lining Company's works on the second floor of a double two-story frame building in the rear of 181 Grand street, Jersey City, got hot at 11 o'clock this morning and set fire to a pile of jute lying near by. Ten men and boys were at work near the picking machine at the time.

In less than a minute the machine and the rooms were in flames. The people employed about the machine were burned on their faces, hands, arms and necks. All hands were saved from the building, save by jumping from windows, others by the hatchway and the remainder by the stairs.

Foreman John C. Mayell, of 222 Grand street, was severely blistered while trying to extinguish the fire. Then he slid down a rope in the hatchway and the burned flesh was torn from his hands. The injured men and boys ran to Police Headquarters, two blocks away, where the patrolmen's waiting-room was converted into a hospital.

Dr. Gray dressed the burns of Mayell and of Joseph Harrison, fourteen years, of 202 Grand street; William Finn, six years old, hands and feet; and an Italian lad, Januario Zezerite, of 77 Colgate street. The faces and hands of these were treated by Dr. Gray.
