FIREMEN NARROWLY ESCAPE. Forced to Jump from the Third Story of a Burning Building.

A \$50,000 Blaze on West Fiftieth and Fifty-First Streets.

Fire broke out about 4:45 o'clock this morning in the works of the Sicilian Asphalt Paving Company, extending from 650 to 658 West Fifty-first street.

The works were one-story frame buildings, surrounded by sheds. The office building, which was saved from destruction, is of brick, one story high.

Engineer Max Hending was in the boiler-room and the night watchman, George Ward, was attending to some business at the river when flames were discovered in what is known as the kiln-room at the west end of the works, where there were eighteen furnaces in which the tires are kept glowing constantly.

These furnaces are used for boiling asphalt and tarring. The supposition is that the blaze was started by some woodwork catching fire from one of the furnaces.
