THE NEGRO HANGED. Awful Fate of the Black Murderer of the Ray Sisters in Kentucky. THOUSANDS SEE HIM DIE. Address by Prominent Men Urging that All Be Done in Order.

BARDWELL, Ky., July 7.—Charles Miller, colored, the brutal murderer of the two Ray sisters, was hanged here this afternoon, in the presence of thousands of people.

BARDWELL, Ky., July 7.—This is the most exciting day that has ever been seen in the history of this peaceful little town. All the trains of last night and this morning have brought in crowds from neighboring towns in Kentucky, Tennessee and Missouri, all anxious to take part in the lynching of Charles Miller, the probable murderer of the two Ray sisters, who was captured at Sikeston, Mo., yesterday.

The negro is a peculiarly constructed man and is well known in this section of the state, having travelled from place to place giving glass-casting and water-drinking exhibitions.

A raw chicken, feathers and entrails, was his favorite dish, and a favorite pastime with him was to eat a cat and swallow bits of lamp chimney, and dirt and clay. He could drink four or five gallons of water without wrinkling his eyes.

At 7:30 A. M. a telegram from Wickliffe, a small town eight miles north of here, stated that the man who had reached there from Sikeston with the prisoner, who was pleading for mercy.

At 8:30 A. M. Prof. J. M. Speight, of Clinton, addressed the mob of citizens, who seem perfectly cool.

Speight begged them to do everything in an orderly way, and not as a matter of show but as a matter of necessity.

This is a prohibition town and no whiskey or other intoxicating liquor has been taken to any of the crowd. Men are here from every town in this part of the state.
