LANGOHER CUTS HIS OWN THROAT.

Troubles at His Home Are Supposed to Have Worsened His Life.

Ludwig Langohr, or Lang, as he was generally known, committed suicide at No. 263 Halsted street, Newark, yesterday afternoon.

He was a native of Baden, forty-seven years old and had been married twenty-three years. Langohr had been employed in Fattoute & Dalrymple's planing mill the last thirteen years.

He began his work yesterday morning at the feed-room for a lantern. Fifteen or twenty minutes later Langohr was seen to fall face downward in blood on the floor.

Fort's first thought was that Langohr had had a fit, but when he saw the blood he found a razor near the man's throat. He gave the alarm to Mr. Fattoute.

Langohr lived with his wife and children at No. 65 Brunswick street. Although his employers pronounce him a temperate, reliable workman, Mrs. Langohr said that drink had brought all his troubles. Her husband, she said, "has always been a hard drinker. On the day we were married, most of the year ago, he got drunk at the reception. The next night we went to a party, and he was intoxicated as usual. I remonstrated with him and he proposed to me to cut my throat and then his own. Last night I induced him to go with me to prayer-meeting the German Lutheran Church. After home I came home he walked the floor and said he would go to bed. This morning he seemed in better spirits. He did not say anything about committing suicide this morning, though he had done so before. Last Sunday he asked me to forgive him for having drunk so much and for abusing me and the children.

The man's domestic relations are known to have been unhappy for a long time.

Fell Dying on Broadway. Thomas Lovell Russell, of No. 1491 Herkimer street, Brooklyn, had been ill for several days with tonsillitis. He was walking up Broadway yesterday afternoon, and had a paroxysm of coughing while crossing Park place. Suddenly he fell, opposite No. 243.

There before an ambulance arrived. He died before a blood vessel was coughed. Mr. Russell was forty-two years old, and leaves a widow and three children.

Mr. Russell was a horticulturist of repute, and was well known to farmers about New York and Brooklyn. He was one of the originators of a journal devoted to the interests of florists and flower culture.
