Charges Against Capt. O'Connor
and Detective Sheridan.
Supt. Byrnes Also Includes Patrolmen
Moody and Miller.
He Alleges Collusion in Protecting
a Pool-Room.

Charges against Police Captain O'Connor, Detective George Sheridan and Patrolmen William Moody and Peter Miller, of the Church street station, will be presented, with the approval of President Martin, to the Police Board at its meeting to-day.

The charges are based on the affidavits of John J. Lynch and William Mayston, who were, it is alleged, maltreated by Detective Sheridan in Poynton's pool-room, in the Merchants' Hotel, where Sheridan, it is charged, was acting as bouncer.

Supt. Byrnes charges Capt. O'Connor with permitting pool-rooms to do business in his precinct, and also with acting in collusion with Detective Sheridan in protecting a pool-room.

Detective Sheridan and Policemen Miller and Moody are charged with failing to perform their duty in not bringing Lynch to the station after they had placed him under arrest.

Sheridan is also charged with dereliction of duty in failing to report the pool-room.

After the Superintendent had formulated the charges, late yesterday afternoon, he submitted them to President Martin, who read the affidavits carefully and then approved the complaints.

Lynch and Mayston's affidavits recite the story which they claim to have been present, and which was summoned and Lynch declared, beat him unmercifully with a club. Then he was turned over to Moody and Miller, who took him to the steps of the Church street station, and then let him go.

Instead, Lynch, accompanied by Mayston, entered the station and told Capt. O'Connor all about the pool-room and Sheridan's treatment of Lynch. They swear the captain denied that there was any such detective attached to his station, and refused to enter into any complaint. Sheridan again set upon and beat Lynch.

Sheridan has been held for trial in the Court of General Sessions, on Lynch's complaint, for aggravated assault. It is also said that Lynch has supplied information about other pool-rooms which existed in Capt. O'Connor's precinct, and which were destroyed by the story of the assault on Lynch in Poynton's pool-room.

STOCK MARKET IS DULL.
Little Speculation and a Fractional Decline in Prices.
Extreme business slowness and speculation at the stock exchange this morning and the lack of business exerted an unfavorable influence on prices.

The declines, however, were merely fractional in a majority of instances, and there were a few strong stocks.

Delaware & Hudson fell 2 to 149; Chicago Gas, 5 1/2 to 32 1/2; Lead preferred, 1 1/2 to 8 1/2; Reading, 5 1/2 to 33 1/2; Union Pacific, 1 1/2 to 21 1/2.

The drop in Delaware & Hudson was due to the belief that the stock at 75 will not be successful. New York City is expected to be a backstop for those who have made a bet on the proposed issue of stock in the city.

"LORD HARBURY" ARRESTED.
Well-Known Swindler Who Has Victimised New Yorkers.

PHILADELPHIA, Pa., April 10.—Thomas Linton Plucker, of New York, otherwise known as the social lion, "Lord Linton Harbury," was arrested last night on the charge of obtaining money under false pretenses.

He has been posing as J. D. Stuart, nephew of Mayor Stuart, and is said to have victimized about 500 people. He created a furor in Camden, N. J., four years ago, where he passed as a lord, and was related to Sir William Harcourt.

After his arrest the police recognized him as Plucker, whose picture is in the Herald of forged and copied letters, and in New Orleans. A memorandum book found in his possession showed he had operated a similar scheme in New York City.

He took back upon his fly-leaf an appeal for contributions for the unemployed in New York City. It was signed by the New York Mission Aid Society, C. A. Andrews, Secretary, and dated Jan. 19, 1894.

The appeal was supplemented by a statement that would appear in the newspapers. The list contained contributions amounting to over \$200, the names including those of Mrs. Chickering, Mrs. Bowler, Mrs. Hickey, Mrs. G. W. Stanton, Mrs. T. Eggleston, Miss Laura Rhinehart, and others.

A large number of other tickets were found upon the swindler's person, and the plotting was broken and diamonds in New York City, Boston and Baltimore.

Found Inmate in the Street.
Ignatius Schwan, forty years old, of 22 West Street was found lying on Fifteenth street and First Avenue, this morning and taken to Bellevue Hospital.

Schwan has been acting strangely for several days. He is supposed to have been caused by a ladder falling on his head a year ago.

HEWITT'S HOUSE FUMIGATED.
The Ex-Mayor's Parlor Maid Has Scarlet Fever.

Taken Away to the Willard Parker Hospital.
The fine residence of ex-Mayor Abram S. Hewitt has just been fumigated by inspectors from the Health Board, and an effort is being made to trace the source of a case of scarlet fever which recently developed there.

Early this morning, twenty years old, a parlor maid in the Willard Parker Hotel, was yesterday removed to Willard Parker Hospital ill with the disease. Ex-Mayor Hewitt and the members of the Health Board have since been endeavoring to keep the facts in the case secret.

The palatial residence of the ex-Mayor is at 9 Lexington avenue, near Gramercy Park. It has many servants, and the first parlor maid, who has been with the family for two years, was a Scotch girl named Mary.

She showed symptoms of fever Sunday, and Dr. Asch, of 5 West Thirty-first street, was called. He was not satisfied as to what was the trouble with the patient.

She died last night, and the house yesterday, and moved around among the servants. Her body, however, was covered with the disease.

The ex-Mayor went to the Health Department and saw Secretary Clark. Inspectors who went to the Lexington avenue house found that neither had scarlet fever, and she was quickly removed. The room, however, was fumigated and every effort made to prevent the spread of the infection.
