

CHOATE V. PRESIDE

Plan to Honor Him at the Constitutional Convention.

Selected by Republicans and is Likely to Accept.

Editor Fitch, of Rochester, Will Probably Be Secretary.

The Republican delegates to the State Constitutional Convention, which will meet in the assembly chamber at the Capitol at Albany on Tuesday, May 8, have settled upon Joseph H. Choate, of this city, as President of the Convention.

As the Republicans are in a large majority, it is a probable that Mr. Choate will be elected, especially as a number of the Democratic delegates are known to be in favor of his candidacy.

The only obstacle to the carrying out of this programme was the unwillingness of Mr. Choate to accept the position on account of the confining character of his duties and the large amount of time of labor that would be involved.

It was learned this morning, however, that after a careful consideration of the matter, Mr. Choate had expressed his willingness to assume the duties of President, provided he was elected to that position and now apparently all the difficulty has been settled.

This information did not come from Mr. Choate, who has never been tendered to him, but one of his most intimate friends, a well-known reporter of "The Evening World," this morning that he had decided to give up in time to the duties of the Convention if he should be chosen to fill the position of presiding officer.

Mr. Choate is fully appreciated the grave importance of this Convention, and of the necessity of such a choice to give his best efforts for the successful and satisfactory accomplishment of the work which has been set out.

In fact, he regards it as the most important event in the history of the State ever held in this State, and the questions which will come before it for consideration will undoubtedly call for the most careful deliberations.

It is said Editor Charles E. Fitch, of the Rochester Democrat, has been selected for the office of Secretary of the Convention. He is the prominent member of the majority so far as the delegates have been canvassed.

The delegates will arrive in the Assembly Chamber on Tuesday, and Secretary John Palmer will call them to order and administer the oath to each member. He will preside until the Convention has been organized and elected its permanent officers.

Provision has been made for the sitting of the Convention from May 8 to Sept. 15, and the Legislature will convene in session until that date. If it does not do so, the delegates will not be entitled to any compensation.

It is, however, the delegates are expected to receive \$10 a day, and salaries are paid to the members of the majority so far as they are employed during the Convention.

The present roll shows ninety-eight Republicans and twenty-two Democrats, with four vacancies caused by death since election to office. There is a strong probability that the roll will be increased by the delegates from the Sixth Brooklyn District, which includes Gravesend.

It is also probable that the roll will be increased by the delegates from the regular Democratic delegation returned from this district.

Details of a Saloon Fight Are Mysteriously Hushed.

There was a great deal of mystery in the Yorkville Court to-day about the dismissal of complaints of felonious assault and violation of the Excise law against Grady, at the bar of Michael Farrell's saloon, Sixty-sixth street and Amsterdam avenue.
