



The southwest wind created a nasty, choppy sea and every few minutes or three big combers would come rushing along and hurl the Assistance over on its side. It seemed as though the boat would roll completely over. It returned a very wet and weary crew, but the boat was not damaged. The Assistance would not have attempted it. The two drags were for distinctly different purposes. One was a heavy, iron affair, very similar to the killick used by fishermen to anchor their boats. Instead of two arms or prongs, it has six. This grapple is used to fasten to the wreck and being away whatever portion it fastened to, which it did yesterday.
