The developments of to-day in the case of the failure of Cohn & Mihselner, wholesale grocers, of 88 Washington street, who, it was alleged, had secreted about \$200,000 worth of goods in various parts of the city with the intention of defrauding their creditors, put a different aspect on the case.

Mr. Marx, of 228 Broadway, who was appointed assignee after the failure on Aug. 4, made a statement this morning which, if it does not entirely clear up the mystery of the imputation of intent to swindle their creditors, reveals them legally of much responsibility.

Several firms of importing grocers of the city, who were in the habit of buying bills of goods from Cohn & Mihselner, were called upon to appear before the assignee.
