"I remember I thanked Smith and told him to buy a couple of bottles of wine for himself. Some time ago I saw the wine, 'Cash, \$50.' That meant \$50 for the Captain. I didn't like to write Captain's name on it."

"Mr. Hess objected again that the items in the book of money paid to month after month to Ward Man Smith, and that there was no suggestion of privacy or secrecy in this block of books."

"I continued to pay the \$50 a month from July down to April, 1893, when I was arrested. I was taken to the East Fifth street station," said Mrs. Sanford. "But I would never have been arrested had it not been for the book."
