

WAS SHE HYPNOTIZED

Mrs. Claus's Strange Story of Her Relations with Snickly.

Went to Milwaukee with Him Under Duress, She Says.

When Her Husband Died She Broke with the Coachman.

Andrew F. Snickly, the German coachman who was arrested yesterday for attempting to shoot the rich widow, Wilhelmina Claus, at her home, 84 Bushwick avenue, was arraigned in Gates Avenue Police Court this morning and held in \$1,600 bail for further examination on Friday next.

Snickly was only an "otter, but he carries, pent up in his German bosom, the force of a Prince Bismarck. He is on trial as the villain or hero in one of the most curious romances and hopelessly mixed up pieces of adventure that ever made a poor, bewildered magistrate scratch his head.

There were witnesses to swear that Snickly is crazy. A madman once ran an express train filled with passengers all the way from Kansas City to Chicago, but it baffles credit that a man of uncanny mind could enter a rich man's family as a coachman and, within a few months, draw his employer into the divorce court and to death, and compel the employer's wife to make an involuntary sojourn of two months in distant Milwaukee.

COACHMAN SNICKLY.

Christian Claus was a man well along in life and with a comfortable fortune when fifteen years ago he married the little girl in her teens who is now his widow. He made his money as a contractor and prospered steadily, and saw years ago he was able to move into and maintain the fine establishment in Bushwick avenue, his residence now.

Early in 1883 he employed for the care of his horses and the driving of his turn-out the present widow Snickly. She was a young girl, and although of low stature, is of pleasant and almost winning smile, and of a good origin and worthy station.

What occurred leading up to his association with Snickly is a matter difficult to reach. Mrs. Claus first said that Snickly had become so familiar in his manner towards her that before the end of the year she had discharged him.
