THORNE A SUICIDE.

Shoots Himself While in His Father's House.

Dependent and Ill Because of Business Troubles.

The Fact that He Took His Own Life Kept Quiet.

Although William S. Thorne, Jr., President of the Red Star Manufacturing Company, of 229 West street, and junior partner of the lubricating oil firm of Dungee & Co., at the same address, committed suicide early yesterday afternoon, the fact that the case was not made public until this afternoon.

Thorne sent a bullet crashing through his brain while at the home of his father, 126 East Seventh street, late President of the Second Avenue Railway Company.

The reason assigned for the taking of his life is said to have been melancholia, the result of worry over business complications. The workman, it is also said, prayed so heavily upon Mrs. Thorne that his health had been undermined.

William S. Thorne, Jr., was thirty-five years of age and lived with his wife and two children at 126 East Seventh street. His father, Mr. Thorne, is the brother of M. H. Dungee of Dungee & Co., of the same address.

Thorne was a member of the Standard Oil Company, of New York, 128 Pearl street, and was in charge of the New York office. The utmost secrecy has been maintained on the part of the friends and relatives of the deceased.

The son of Thorne, it is said, is lying close to his father, and remains very ill. Mrs. Thorne, who was notified by the servant, summoned an ambulance from Roosevelt Hospital. She was taken to the hospital, where she died later.

At the carpenter shop of Gustav P. Tausig, it was stated that Mrs. Thorne had been in his house yesterday, Monday, Oct. 6, when he said he would go to his room.

Not long afterwards a pistol shot was heard, but no attention was paid to it for a time.

At about 4 o'clock, however, some one called at the house and found that the little half-bred had led a letter in his hand. The letter was addressed to the Parkhurst Society. Lawyer Moss said that the line of defense would be that Thorne had been in the house at the time of the shooting.

BULLET IN HER HEAD.

Mrs. Taussig Finally Succeeds in Killing Herself.

Her Little Daughter Found at the Mother's Side.

Mrs. Armenia Taussig, twenty-nine years old, of 162 West Eighty-fifth street, committed suicide today by shooting herself in the left temple with a revolver.

Mrs. Taussig was the sister of Gustav P. Tausig, a carpenter and builder, of 22 West Twenty-seventh street. Last June, soon after the death of her mother, she showed signs of mental weakness. She attempted suicide at that time by attempting to swallow Paris green, but was prevented from taking her life by relatives.

Mrs. Taussig was taken to Long Branch for her health, and returned about three months ago. She appeared improved in health.

This morning she called on her neighbor, Mrs. L. W. Havens, of 196 West Eighty-fifth street. To Mrs. Taussig's surprise, Mrs. Havens' maid found her lying on the stairs, found her mistress lying on the floor unconscious.
