STREEP'S TESTIMONY OUT.

Mayor Will Not Have the Accusation Against Comstock Recorded. The plans of Mr. Goff and the members of the Lexow Committee, as already announced, are changed very materially, this will be the last day of the police investigation, for the present at least.

The chief counsel declared very positively several days ago that he intended to sever the connection with the Committee as an examiner at the close of today's session, and it is a well-known fact that early last week some of the members, including the chairman, were in favor of sending up the investigation. They said they had already secured sufficient evidence of the prevailing corruption in the Police Department to enable them to set on foot the investigation necessary to correct the existing evils.

It was rumored this morning that the unsatisfactory result of Inspector Williams' examination had confirmed the members of the Committee in the view that little additional evidence of blackmail and bribery could be obtained by putting other high police officials on the witness stand. It was also rumored that the corruption fund that was so industriously collected by ward men, sergeants and captains to the final result, they would be met by wholesale details and contradictions of the testimony of previous witnesses, as in the case of Inspector Williams.

So many witnesses, however, have been called who remain to be examined, that it will be impossible to secure the testimony of all of them in a single day. Inspector McAvoy, Capt. Martens and his wife, and a host of other officials have been called to attend a week-long session for a week awaiting their turn to take the witness chair.
