LABOR NEWS.

The compromise which was arrived at by the Sheet Metal Workers' Union and the Wire Lathers' Union has been re-

mediated by the Building Trades Council and the fight between the two organizations will continue. The fact that the two unions had agreed upon a settlement of the fight and that in future they should divide the work and recognize the cards of the other body was reported to the council at its last meeting. Many members were indignant that such a plan should be carried out without their knowledge and the action was taken. The plan agreed on by DeLozier's "Carpenter," of the wire lathers, may result in his suspension as a delegate.
