POLICEMEN SAVE LIVES

Two Officers Rescue Madison Avenue Tenants.

Fire in the Miner Apartment House, Sixty-third street and Madison avenue, early this morning forced nearly a score of persons to flee over roofs and down fire-escapes for their lives and did about \$50,000 damage.

It is a modern fireproof structure, and every one of the ten apartments has tenants. Seven of the families were away for the summer when shortly before 4 o'clock this morning Thomas McCourtly, a special watchman, saw flames burst forth from the third story.

Dr. Harry A. Cohen and his aged mother live on the first floor. They were helped through the windows safely by Policeman Walsh, of the East Sixty-seventh street station.

I. M. Cohen and his wife and three children live on the second floor. Mr. and Mrs. William E. Dodd were on the floor above.

The fire-escape extended only to the second floor. Between that and the street was a drop of about fourteen feet. Unable to go through the halls, the seven persons fled to the fire-escape, where they stood in their night clothes, shrieking for help.

Policemen Lydig and Lundy, of the East Sixty-seventh street station, ran to help them. It was too far for any one to jump, and Lydig, who is an athlete, climbed the coping until he reached the bottom of the fire-escape.

Then, hanging by one hand, he passed every one of the seven down to his brother officer on the sidewalk.

When Lydig reached the sidewalk he could not use the arm by which he had swung from the fire-escape. It was strained by the sudden weight it had borne. It will be some time before it will be well again.

The firemen, after a hard fight, mastered the blaze, but not before it had almost completely gutted the building. Owing to the absence of the tenants the amount of damage to furniture, paintings and bric-a-brac is not definitely known. It is estimated at \$50,000.

The fire started, it is thought, in the tailor shop of Rosenstein & Son, on the first floor.

FIRE SWEEPS CITY.

Whole Business Portion of Bloomington, Ill., Razed To-Day.

BLOOMINGTON, Ill., June 15.—Five blocks of the best business buildings located in the heart of this city were destroyed by fire, which started at 12:30 o'clock this morning.

The fire started in the Court-House, valued at \$60,000, is a total loss, but the records were saved. Nearly fifty firms were burned out, and it is estimated that the loss will foot up between \$500,000 and \$1,000,000.

Two firemen are missing and are believed to have been buried in the ruins. The leading hotels, the Windsor and Phoenix, were burned, but all the guests escaped.

At 5:30 o'clock, after eight hours' hard work, the combined fire departments of this city, Peoria and Springfield had brought the flames to a standstill in the block west of the Court-House, and the fire was soon after gotten under control.

The burned district included some of the handsomest buildings in the city. Among the buildings destroyed and some of the losses are the following:

FIRE STAMPEDED TENANTS.

Little Blaze in Basement Scared Occupants of Big East Side Tenement.

Two hundred or more occupants of the six-story tenement at 76 and 78 Cannon street had a bad scare this morning, caused by a slight fire in the basement.

A painter dropped a lit candle into a can of turpentine, setting the place afire. Some one yelled "fire," and the frightened tenants made a wild dash for the street by stairs and fire-escapes.

The fire was small and the blaze was quickly extinguished.
