### POLICE CAUGHT THIEF IN CHURCH

Man Stole Silver Trays and Mass Service Bells in St. Francis Xavier's in Sixteenth Street.

After a chase of two blocks to-day George B. Foster, thirty-five years old, a tailor, was caught by a policeman who said the man had robbed the Roman Catholic Church of St. Francis Xavier, in Sixteenth street, between Fifth and Sixth avenues. The watchman who guards the church discovered that one of the windows had been opened. He called the policeman, who summoned other policemen, and the church was surrounded. Foster jumped out of the window and ran toward Sixth avenue. The policeman chased him and heading fourteenth street Foster stopped and surrendered.  
 In his pockets were four silver trays and the mass service bells. He was poorly dressed and refused to make any statement.  
 The Church of St. Francis Xavier is one of the largest and most prominent of the Roman Catholic churches in the city and is managed by the Jesuit Fathers. The police say that the prisoner also tried to rob the poor-boxes and the contributions to watch in this church amount to no small sum.  
 At the more valuable of the poorest vessels are kept in a safe in the rectory, and it would be almost impossible for any one to steal them.
