

BRITISH TAKE AN AWFUL REVENGE ON MAD MULLAH

Gen. Manning Leads the Main Column Against the Fanatic's Followers in Somaliland and Administers a Crushing Defeat, Killing 2,000 and Scattering the Remainder—British Loss Is Not Stated.

ADEN, Arabia, April 25.—The British force in Somaliland has avenged the slaughter by the followers of the Mad Mullah of the detachment from Col. Cobbe's flying column, when Col. Plunkett, nine other officers and 174 men were killed by a horde of the Mullah's Mahometans while hurrying to the relief of another detachment.

Brig-Gen. Manning, commanding the main column of the British troops, after a heavy engagement with the Mad Mullah's forces has relieved Col. Cobbe, near Gumburru, Somaliland, forty-five miles westward of Galadi.

About two thousand of the Mullah's men were killed. The British loss is not known.

THE DISASTER TO COL. PLUNKETT.

The few details obtainable of the disaster to Col. Plunkett's detachment on April 17 show the Mullah's forces consisted of 2,000 horsemen and 10,000 spearmen.

They surrounded Col. Plunkett's force in the open and, after a heavy rifle fire, charged repeatedly with their horsemen and spearmen on all sides. The British detachment held out until its ammunition was exhausted and then endeavored to hold its square with the bayonet, but was ultimately overwhelmed by weight of numbers.

The British force fought until all its officers and 170 men were killed. Most of the handful of men who reached camp were wounded. The Somalis' losses are believed to have been enormous.

The Mullah's forces are reported to aggregate from three to four thousand horsemen and about eighty thousand spearmen.

TYNER RETURNS POSTAL PAPERS.

Big Bundle of Documents, Declared Taken from Department Safe by ex-Officials's Wife, Turned over by Lawyers

WASHINGTON, April 25.—Attorneys Perry and Michener, counsel for Gen. and Mrs. Tyner, to-day submitted to Postmaster-General Payne papers purporting to be the ones taken from the safe in the department by Mrs. Tyner last Tuesday.

Mr. Payne had addressed a letter to them declining to consider a proposition to either visit personally or send a representative to visit the Tyner residence, but said he would receive the attorneys at the department and look at any papers they might choose to submit.

Accordingly at noon to-day the attorneys brought an immense bundle of papers to the private office of the Postmaster-General. There Mr. Payne and Fourth Assistant Postmaster-General Bristol, who has charge of the investigation, examined them.

PUBLIC MUST PAY MEAT TRUST FINES.

Kansas City Combine Doing Business Again in Spite of the Courts.

KANSAS CITY, April 25.—Five packers in a combine paid \$5,000 each last week as a fine imposed by the Supreme Court of Missouri for conspiring to fix prices on meats. This week they are fixing prices as of yore, and have already marked them up sufficiently to cover the cost of defending the prosecution many times over.



NEWSDEALERS APPEAL TO LOW

Mayor Refers Them to Police Commissioner Greene, Who Advises Them to Have Sidewalk Ordinance Modified.

The arrest of six newsdealers recently for alleged violation of the law pertaining to sidewalk stands caused Thomas F. Martin to appeal to-day to Mayor Low. The Mayor referred Mr. Martin, who is president of the Newsdealers' Association, to Commissioner Greene.

At Headquarters President Martin got no further satisfaction than advice to have the law changed. "This law was framed by the Board of Aldermen," said Commissioner Greene, and you cannot blame Capt. Piper for enforcing it. If it is unfair I have no doubt the board will make a proviso."

Mr. Martin immediately consulted lawyers and by next Tuesday he will have an ordinance introduced mitigating or entirely doing away with the present restriction.

JAPAN MISEADING US, RUSSIAN OFFICIALS SAY.

ST. PETERSBURG, April 25.—The officials of the Foreign Office here expressed intense surprise to-day at the report that American public opinion was disturbed by the news regarding Manchuria. They declared the people of the United States were being misled by Japan, and said that the improvements which were in progress in Manchuria certainly would benefit international commerce.

The Foreign Office officials added that no new fundamental conditions were being imposed, claiming that what are now in progress are four points concerning the act of evacuation itself and the organization of the Chinese administration to assure order.

The Chinese administration, however, is not ready. Russia desires an assurance that China will maintain a sufficient police force to repress local disorders, which are continuous throughout Manchuria, especially in the mountains.

WHY NOT LOCK UP THIS MAN?

Policeman Is Under the Grave Charge of Beating His Baby Nearly to Death with Club, Yet Wears Uniform.

HE DENIES THE CHARGES.

In a hospital, under the care of the Children's Society, Tommy Clarke, two and one-half years old, lies in an unconscious condition. His frail body is covered with scars and bruises, and Dr. W. Travis Gibb, who is attending the child, is doubtful about his recovery.

Policeman William A. Clarke, the child's father, accused of having inflicted the wounds, is enjoying a peculiar form of imprisonment at the Thirty-third Precinct station. Clarke is what the police call a "paroled prisoner." Although charged with cruelty to his child, he is permitted to wear his uniform and has the freedom of the station. This courtesy has been extended to him by Magistrate Hogan.

While Clarke is allowed to roam about, his wife is under arrest charged with neglecting the child. She was taken in custody several days after charges had been filed against her husband.

Not True, Says Clarke. Clarke declares that he is a much-abused man. He says he did not beat his child, as charged by Mrs. Emily Pierson and Mrs. Martha Benson, his neighbors, and tries to lay the blame for the trouble on his wife.

When a reporter for The Evening World called at the police station Clarke stepped out of a room where several officers were playing checkers. He wore his uniform, club and helmet. "This thing has pretty near worried me to death," he said. "Of course I never whipped my child as those two women said. That charge don't worry me any. But it's come right on top of some trouble I've been having with my wife. I've had her committed to institutions several times, and recently she has been acting up again."

"No, she never beat the youngster, but she's given me a lot of trouble, and her actions may have had something to do with the charges made against me. Every one around the station knows that I'm all right. If they didn't, do you think they would let me go around with my uniform on as I am now?"

He Always Looked Starved. "I never whipped that child in my life. He always was a puny kind, and, although my wife and I gave him all he wanted, he looked sort of starved. As to his having bruises on his body, I don't know anything about them. A bow fell on him a few days ago and a scar was inflicted on his forehead, but outside of that he wasn't hurt any."

Mrs. Pierson and Mrs. Benson, however, told a different story at the first hearing of the case. They live in an apartment adjoining that of the Clarks, at No. 204 Amsterdam avenue. "The way that child was treated was an outrage," said Mrs. Pierson. "Mrs. Benson and I were standing in the kitchen of our flat, and could see the

interior of the Clarks flat across the way from us. We saw that little baby sitting in a chair gnawing at a crust of bread. Pretty soon it began crying. Then Clarke came in. He didn't have on his uniform. He got a stick with some string on the end and began beating the baby unmercifully. Then after he had done this he choked it. The thing was so revolting that I at once notified the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children."

Clarke for the Baby. "I saw him beat the child with a huge whin," said Mrs. Benson. "and then he choked it. Mrs. Pierson and I had noticed the little one for several weeks. At meal times it would have a little chair near where its parents and the older children ate, and they wouldn't give it anything but stale crusts of bread."

Clarke has been connected with the Police Department for several years. During most of this time he has been stationed in the Thirty-third Precinct. The complaint book at the station shows that he has been fined several times for neglect of duty. On Feb. 22, 1899, Roundsmen Leff charged him with failing to patrol his beat properly, and he got a reprimand. In March, 1900, he was charged with a similar offense and was fined. In November he was fined for being absent from his post, and in another fine was imposed for a similar offense. He was also fined in the West One Hundred and Fifty-second Street Police Court next Tuesday.

SCORED PARTNER IN HIS LAST WILL

Mr. Strohm Revealed the "Contempt" He Felt for Mr. Reitzenstein, but the Latter Lives and Was Sorry to Hear It.

After a partnership of thirty-eight years and an occasional friendship of fourteen years after they had retired from business, the will of the late A. A. Strohm revealed the fact that he held H. G. Reitzenstein in silent contempt. In strong terms he denounces his former partner as "mean, selfish and greedy."

The terms of this remarkable document have just been made public, although Mr. Strohm died in the Hotel St. George last October and the will was probated December 29. It was written in 1838, and friends say that this apparent enmity was forgotten in later years. The remarkable paragraph is as follows:
