

FASHION HAS SHOW OF ITS OWN

Madison Square Garden Given Over to a Bewildering Collection of the Thousand and One Accessories of the Toilet.

POEMS OF FORM AND COLOR.

Paris Sends More than a Hundred Creations and an Expert to Lecture on Them and There Are Native Products of All Sorts.

If you are a woman and have ordered your fall gown to be made in a long suit coat—three-quarter coat—is the technical term—you will want it altered after a visit to the Fashion Show at Madison Square Garden.

The lady who has made up her mind for a velvet gown or who has ordered the flare of her skirt more pronounced than this season's model will feel happy, for she is right in line with the latest Paris pronouncement.

All these things and many more that the mind of ordinary man is not able to encompass in the realms of chiffon and lingerie can be learned at the display of foreign and American fashions which are displayed for the delectation of femininity at Madison Square Garden.

The show is not at all like the display made at last spring's dressmakers' convention. The Parisian designers have sent over a splendid line of models—150 in all—and along with them comes a delegate, Mr. Otto Adler, to discourse on all that is up to date in European fashions.

He is to lecture during the show for the benefit of those who might not be able to appreciate unassisted the wonders of foreign modality.

The collection of French gowns is probably the finest and largest ever exhibited in this country. The models range in price from \$3,000 to \$200. Some of them are freakish, some striking and many really beautiful.

Besides the exhibition of gowns, there are displays of silks, laces, hosiery, neckwear, millinery, hats and a collection of accessories. There are corsets, too, silk skirts and lingerie in bewildering displays which the patron would like to linger over, but dare not.

Altogether, the Fashion Show is a goodly and desirable exhibit to delight the heart of womanhood for the next two weeks, and it may attract the more to it the living models presented by the promoters are placed on view.


