SAYS THE POLICE HOUND SALOON MEN

Tekulsky Alleges Patrolmen
 Were Ordered to Make Ar-
 rests in Places Where Mc-
 Clellan Pictures Were Shown.

Morris Tekulsky, Chairman of the
 Campaign Committee of the United Lib-
 erty League, an organization established
 by saloon-keepers, brewers and liquor
 dealers opposed to the re-election of
 Mayor Low, declared to-day that the po-
 lice have been instructed to enforce the
 Excise law in every saloon in the win-
 dow of which a lithograph of George B.
 McClellan is displayed.

The order was issued direct from Po-
 lice Headquarters, says Tekulsky, and
 was directed to police precinct captains.
 Commissioner Greene makes positive
 denial of the statement and no police
 captain will acknowledge that any such
 order was received. Chairman Tekulsky
 said:

"The order went direct from Police
 Headquarters. Saloon, cafe, restaurant
 and hotel men were pestered yesterday
 by squads of plain-clothes men who
 were stationed near the places in which
 McClellan lithographs were displayed for
 the express purpose of making arrests
 in those places.

Persecution Is Alleged.
 "The police are thus trying to hound,
 persecute and oppress respectable
 trades or compel their support of the Fu-
 sion ticket.

"The United Liberty League will re-
 sist all such efforts to humiliate and
 oppress our members by appealing to the
 courts."

Mayor Low takes emphatic exception to
 the statements of Tammany speakers
 as to the division of the excise moneys
 between the city and the State.
 "Tammany Hall is indulging in its
 usual misrepresentation," said the
 Mayor in a statement to-day. "Tam-
 many claims that the State is robbing
 the city to the extent of \$5,000,000. The
 facts are these:

The Mayor's Statement.
 "The State's share of the excise fees
 this year was \$5,483,204.62. Of this sum
 the State of New York paid \$5,746,728.11.
 The State has to have this amount of
 money, and if it did not get it in this
 way it would have to levy a direct tax
 for the same amount. The city of New
 York pays this year the share of the direct
 tax, and this percentage of the above
 sum is \$5,746,451.59. The difference be-
 tween the sum that would be due from
 the city by direct tax and the sum paid
 in excise fees is \$241.62. In other words,
 the city pays the same percentage of
 the excise fees and of the direct State
 tax. If the State took only one-third
 of the excise fees the result would be
 the same. What the State did not get
 from excise it would get by direct tax,
 and the city would pay the same pro-
 portion of the smaller sum represented
 by the excise fees as it would pay of the
 direct tax.

"The payment by the city of \$5,746,-
 451.59 to the State from excise fees re-
 lates to the real and personal estate of the
 city of taxation to the same amount,
 thus making our tax rate about 4 points
 lower than it otherwise would be. In
 addition the city's share of the excise
 fees under the new law, is larger than
 it was by more than \$200,000, so that all
 the pension funds which receive a pro-
 portion of the excise fees kept by the
 city get larger sums than before."

 The police of the West One Hundred
 and Fifty-second street station have
 been asked to find Edward Reed, four-
 teen years, who has been missing from
 his home, No. 52 West One Hundred
 and Fifty-ninth street, since Oct. 24. At
 the time of his disappearance he wore a
 gray coat and vest, black long trousers
 and a sweater. He has light brown hair
 and is tall for his age.
