SUSPICIOUS FIRES IN TWO FLAT-HOUSES

Police Think that Incendiaries Started Blazes in West Ninetieth and Ninety-first Streets—Fire Marshal Investigating.

Fires were discovered last night within half an hour of each other in the flat-houses at No. 132 West Ninety-first street and No. 141 West Ninetieth street. Each seemed so palpably of incendiary origin that the police asked the Fire Marshal's office to investigate.

The fire in the Ninety-first street house was discovered at 6 o'clock in a heap of rubbish at the dumbwaiter shaft. William Twomey, the janitor, gave the alarm to tenants after calling the engines, and the fifteen families, many of them at their supper, left the house hurriedly. The firemen extinguished the fire with little difficulty.

The second fire was discovered half an hour later. Rubbish had been fired under the stairway, and before the tenants were aware of it the halls were filled with smoke to the third floor. Here again there was a stampede of tenants. Before the firemen arrived the fire had eaten its way to the third floor stairway and caused a damage of \$600.

The janitors of the houses say that no rubbish was in the places a short time before the fires were started, but no one could be found who had seen any one carrying rubbish to the cellars, or loitering about the places.
