HOW THE VICKSBURG HELPED THE RUSSIANS

WASHINGTON, March 1.—The text of the message to the Navy Department from Commander Marshall, of the Vicksburg, was as follows: "Took the initiative by sending medical assistance to the Varig as soon as possible after learning that they were abandoning vessel. Sent three boats and assisted taking off the Russian sailors, putting them on board the British and Italian vessels. The Varig remained afloat over five hours, filling slowly. Our boats were instructed not to bring the Russian sailors to Vicksburg, offering the Zafro temporarily, but the offer was declined."


