

ROBBERS POISON ANOTHER VICTIM

Samuel Schneider Gets Here from Boston, Gets Knockout Drops and Is Saved from Death by Dr. Emily Dunning.

FOUND UNCONSCIOUS LYING ON SIDEWALK.

Said to Have Had Money Taken from Him, and a Number of Persons are Arrested Accused of Having Drugged Him

Samuel Schneider, twenty-six years old, of No. 225 Stanton street, is the latest victim of the "dope gang" that has been reaping a harvest on the East Side during the past few weeks.

Schneider, owing to the heroic work of Dr. Emily Dunning, of Gouverneur Hospital, is in a fair way to recovery at that institution.

Other victims of the gang that has been using knockout drops with such frequency on the east side were not so fortunate.

In connection with Schneider's case the following persons have been arrested: Louis Poles, his cousin, twenty-six years old, of No. 225 Stanton street;

forty-three years old, of No. 165 Orchard street. Came here from Boston, Schneider and Robner, who are tailors, arrived from Boston. According to Robner, Schneider had \$25 in a pocket-book in his pocket. They went to the Orchard street address, where they met the others.

Physician's Diagnosis. A hurry call was sent to Gouverneur Hospital and Dr. Emily Dunning responded. She pronounced it a case of opium poisoning at once, and immediately went to work with a will to save Schneider's life.

When found on the sidewalk Schneider's pockets contained no money. His pocketbook was found in Voloshen's possession, although he had no money.
