## WAR OF MAGNATES STIRS THE BROKERS

### Conferences of Railroad Men Give Color to Report of Combination Between Rockefeller and Gould to Fight Harriman.

Northwestern Railway stocks showed strong advances in the stock market today, Union Pacific and St. Paul leading, the basis of the strength being a report printed to-day that Standard Oil interests and the Goulds have combined in an attack upon E. H. Harriman, and that a part of the plan is a contest for getting control of the Union Pacific common stock, while the Goulds and the St. Paul will benefit.

No confirmation of this report is obtainable in Wall street to-day, and, in fact, it is generally argued that there are no indications of unfriendliness between Harriman and the Rockefeller. It is stated that James Stillman, of the National City Bank, is recently on a long trip with Mr. Harriman, and that he still holds close relations with financial interests close to Mr. Harriman.

Hill Also Named.

There were further reports that James J. Hill was in some way concerned in the alleged quarrel, and that the Northern Securities would figure in some way. Men close to Mr. Hill would give no information on this direct point. There was talk of a coming plan for giving to Northern Securities stockholders a dividend of some kind, and as has been the talk since the distribution of the stocks was prevented for a while by the Harriman court proceedings.

It was stated to-day that while the Hill side is trying to think out some way to take care of the stockholders no plan has been decided on yet. Wall Street was a bit anxious over the news that conferences that appeared to be important were being held in this city between men who are concerned in the Northwestern Railway situation. A peculiar part of the news was that the Rockefeller seemed to be represented, but instead of being a conference that might be considered as against Mr. Harriman they were conferring with the bankers who were close to him.

ings of the last year or two point to a close business rivalry between Harriman and Gould. It will be remembered that Harriman, with Edwin Hawley, who was then a member of the Harriman board, was opposed to George Gould in the fight for control of the Colorado Fuel and Iron Company.

Recently there was an outbreak of what looked like hostilities in the West between the Harriman and the Gould properties over the very concrete. There was some rate cutting reported, and it was stated that the Harriman side had cut freight rates on steel products from the East in order to meet the action of the Colorado Fuel and Iron Company and the Gould roads in mutually favoring each other.

Hawley with Gould.

Edwin Hawley has since left the Harriman board and has apparently allied himself with George Gould. The news of his effort to wrest control of the Chicago and Alton from Mr. Harriman is fresh, and the results of the effort will soon be seen. Mr. Hawley has entered the board of the Western Pacific, controlled by Gould, and there are local reports of his holding of a transcontinental system of Gould roads, with the Rockefeller incidentally interested.

Under the lead of Union Pacific the stock market continued strong throughout the session to-day and closed at top figures with trading active. Union Pacific after opening off 1-16 per cent, at 39-1/2 rallied right after the start and sold up to more than 1 point on heavy buying. The rise in this stock brought out comparatively heavy foreign selling.

The buying of United States Steel preferred was notable, the price advancing over 1 point. The common showed a little resistance, but closed a trifle higher. Amalgamated Copper sold up almost 1 point after starting 1-4 lower.

The local trade was closed 1-2 higher under the lead of Metropolitan Securities, which showed a gain of more than 1 point. Bonds were fairly active.

The total sales of stocks were 656,100 shares and of bonds \$3,944,000.
