

# \$1,000 WORTH OF SILVER FOUND

### Police Believe They Have Unearthed Several Robberies by Discovery of Property in Trunk in Negro's Cellar.

Joseph Barrett, colored, twenty-seven years old, a porter, of 120 West Twenty-ninth street, and wife, Pearl, twenty-three years old, a waitress, were arrested and locked up in the West Thirtieth street station last night as suspicious persons.

A week ago the couple squandered an advertisement and were employed at the boarding-house of Helen E. Hunt, No. 141 Madison avenue. Sunday night four dozen solid silver spoons disappeared from Mrs. Hunt's home, and yesterday morning Miss Olney, the housekeeper, discovered that cheap plated ware had been substituted in their place.

Detective Murtha, of the West Thirtieth street station, was notified, and made an investigation. Barrett, to prove his innocence, took the detective to the cellar to show him his trunk, which he said had been broken open and burglarized.

Murtha saw that the lock had been clumsily pried open, and became suspicious. He thereupon went to the home address of the couple. It is alleged that in a trunk there was discovered solid and plated silver which the police valued at \$1,000. The silverware of Mrs. Hunt was not located, however. From the amount found and the value of it the police believe that there have unearthed several robberies.

There were about 125 different pieces. One full silver service, of Tiffany & Co.

### WOMAN SUES BANKRUPT.

Claims Dividend Does Not Absolve Him of Debt.

Suing a bankrupt for \$1,250.00 on a demand note, Kate E. Howe relies upon a recent decision of the Supreme Court, Appellate Division, that when a debt is contracted by misrepresentation and fraud a discharge in bankruptcy does not release the bankrupt from liability under the United States Bankruptcy law.

Miss Howe alleges that George S. Noyes persuaded her on New Year's Day, 1899, to take her savings, \$1,400, out of the trust company, where it was earning only 2 per cent. interest, and lend it to him at 6 per cent., telling her that he had \$50,000 invested in the prosperous firm of Hamilton, Noyes & Co., manufacturers of leather goods. She says this representation was false. In April, 1902, \$150.00 was paid on the note, and she demands the rest, but says that in bankruptcy proceedings he was discharged from all debts. The trustee in bankruptcy paid Miss Howe the \$150.00 as her dividend in his assets.

# CHLOROFORMED IN BED BY THIEF

### Mr. and Mrs. Elmer Whitelaw Robbed of \$2,000 by Persons Who Then Turned on the Gas, It is Alleged.

Albert Belden, a well-known pick-pocket and all-around crook, and Minnie Marquette, said to be his accomplice, were brought back to this city from Peoria, Ill., today.

They were recently indicted for grand larceny and assault. On Sept. 23, it is alleged, the two hired a room from Mrs. Elmer Whitelaw, at No. 202 West Thirty-sixth street. While Mr. and Mrs. Whitelaw were asleep that same night, it is alleged, they chloroformed them and robbed them of \$2,000 in money and jewelry.

They then turned on four gas jets. It is asserted, and left the couple to be asphyxiated. Another boarder in the house smelled the gas and discovered the predicament of the couple just in time to save their lives. A description of the two was given to the police and they were traced to Peoria, where Detectives Flannery and Peabody, of this city, arrested them several days ago.

The pair were negotiating for the purchase of a restaurant when captured. All of the jewelry and most of the money was recovered. The prisoners were committed to the Tombs without bail by Recorder Goff.
