Barden Was Trying to Convince Her It Would Not Blow Up Baby.



When he got home he looked around for a good place to keep them, and finally decided the safest place was under his pillow. When it came time to retire, Mrs. Barden, who has a three-months-old baby which sleeps in a crib beside the bed, objected to having the dynamite in bed with her.

Barden scoffed at her fears, and when Mrs. Barden protested he proceeded to demonstrate that the explosive was perfectly harmless unless touched off with a cap. He bagged it around the room a few times until Mrs. Barden was hysterical from fright, and then, as she was still unconvinced, he took a stick of it and put it down the back of her dress.

Mrs. Barden ran out of the house yelling for help. She met Policeman Hayes and told him there was a stick of dynamite down her back, and that her husband was trying to blow her up. Hayes performed the delicate task of removing the explosive, and then went to the house and arrested Barden. He had him in the First Criminal Court before Judge Higgins to-day. Barden protested that he meant no harm, and was finally allowed to go on his promise never to bring dynamite home again.
