

ONE YEAR AGO TO-DAY 1,020 LIVES WERE LOST

A Monument Is Unveiled in Lutheran Cemetery at Middle Village to Those Who Died in the Great Disaster at the Burning of the General Slocum.

One year ago to-day the steamer General Slocum, with an excursion party of over 1,500 persons belonging to St. Mark's Lutheran Church, was destroyed by fire and sunk, causing the greatest loss of life by fire in or about this city.

BY RAIL UNDER BEHRING STRAIT

American Capitalists and Engineers Indorse Plans of M. de Lobel, Who Has Secured a Land Grant from Russia.

Lofeg de Lobel, who is to build a railroad tunnel under Behring Strait, making possible a trip by rail from New York to Paris, sailed this morning on the French line steamship La Savoie. He goes over to present to the Russian Government the signatures of over thirty American capitalists and engineers who approve his plans and who will act as his American executive committee. The Russian Government is interested in the proposed road and has given M. de Lobel a land grant of eight miles on each side of the tracks where they run through Russian territory. M. de Lobel said that his stay here had been most successful as far as his all-rail route was concerned and that he believed the proposed road would receive a substantial subsidy from the Government. Indeed, he declared President Roosevelt had expressed in favor of giving the subsidy just as the Russian Government had become interested and given the land grants. Soundings and a preliminary survey have already been made, said M. de Lobel. We will begin at once the work of making the survey on the Alaskan side and in November a preliminary of a \$200,000,000 estimate will be begun. It will take two years to build the Alaskan side of the proposed line and three years to build the Siberian.

the institutions of North Brother Island to-day for all who wish to visit there. Boats leave the East One Hundred and Thirty-second street ferry every half hour to accommodate the visitors. There will be no ceremony of any kind. Up to date not one person has been punished for negligence in connection with this horror, although several trials of officials have taken place.

According to official figures compiled by Police Inspector Schmittberger shortly after the disaster the total number of those lost is 1,020. Of this number 859 bodies were recovered, while 61 persons have never been accounted for. The list of injured figured at 189, leaving only 235 who escaped being hurt.

The only ceremonies in commemoration of the event will take place in Lutheran Cemetery, in Middle Village, where a monument will be unveiled over the graves of the unknown dead. It is 8 feet 8 inches square and 30 feet high. On one side is a bronze plate, with a reproduction of the burning steamer in bas-relief. At the right of the central shaft is a figure of Memory.

At the left Grief, and at the top stand Faith and Hope. Each figure is of life size. The monument cost \$15,000 and the money was gathered by members of the Slocum Survivors' Society. The Health Board has thrown open


