

SHOTS FIRED AT DESERTER AS HE FLEES

Corporal Heartbroken Over Loss of Man He Brought from Lancaster.

Old New York, the place about Old Slip, Beaver and Pearl streets, where thoroughfare change names and run every way to confuse the newcomer, was the scene of a chase early to-day for a deserter from the army, in which a corporal awakened the neighborhood with the firing of his revolver.

Corporal Henry A. Jager, of Company A, Eighth Regiment, quartered at Governor's Island, was sent to Lancaster, Pa., a few days ago, to bring back Meyer C. Long, a deserter. With Long he arrived in the city last night. Long apparently had reconciled himself to being made a prisoner.

While on the way to take the boat to Governor's Island the pair stopped to have a few drinks. In front of the Army Building Long made a break for liberty. Jager wrestled with him until Long threw him off and took it on the run.

Before he had reached the corner, Jager had his revolver out and had taken one shot at the fugitive. It woke the police for blocks. From them on Jager was fifty yards in the rear, taking shots at Long, who turned every corner he came to.

He finally lost himself somewhere near Old Slip, with police coming in every direction in response to the shots fired by Jager.

Jager was heartbroken over the loss of his prisoner, and at last accounts was searching the river front, certain that his man must be in hiding about some of the craft tied up in South street.
