Indicted Packers While Demurring to Nine Counts Will Plead Not Guilty to One—in Court Next Monday.

CHICAGO, Oct. 6.—Demurring to nine counts, pleas of not guilty on one count are to be entered next Monday by the seventeen men and five corporations, indicted on charges of conspiracy to monopolize the meat business.
