

GREAT CROWDS SEE HACKNEYS AT HORSE SHOW

Royal Equine Exhibit Draws Society Folk Out Early.

Royalty having given the Horse Show a flying start, what is royal in horseflesh, the hackney, followed in the proper order of things and absorbed the greater part of the interest of to-day's exhibitions.

Eben L. Jorday, whose Plymouth Hackney Stud at Forge Farm, Chiltonville, Mass., is famous all over the world, as usual had the greater number of entries, and there was every promise that he would win the same share of success in 1905 that he did last year, carrying away from the Garden the greatest number of blue ribbons of any exhibitor.

The stir and bustle in the Garden began at an unusually early hour to-day and before 9 o'clock nearly every style of horse manning that has been entered in the 13 different classes was out on the tankard.

Rival ponies and heavy harness horses of Retznick and Alfred Vanderbilt were out in the hands of their trainers, teams of trotters and pacers abut around the tankard by the rail, marking a boundary within which hunters and saddle horses cantered and danced.

The cream of the entries in the jumping classes were tried out at an early hour over the "stone" hedge, a block of sheet iron made to represent masonry, which is a new feature in the jumps this year.






