Even the most gloomy forebodings of financial stringency failed to dispel the bullish sentiment that dominates the market. Several influential brokers telegraphed to Secretary Shaw asking him to relieve the situation by depositing \$20,000,000 or \$30,000,000 of additional government funds in the New York banks.

The trading to-day was of a peculiar character and it included extensive liquidation of pool stocks. A large quantity of American Locomotive stock was disposed of at prices claimed to be about 20 per cent. above the pool's purchasing price.

More definite facts regarding the new pool in Tennessee coal and iron were disclosed to-day. There are ten men in the syndicate, the leading spirits being Grant B. Schley, John W. Gates, C. S. Guthrie and Charles Thorne. It is affirmed that this syndicate has bought, up to date, more than 120,000 shares of Tennessee Coal and Iron common stock.

An unusual degree of interest is manifested in the affairs of the Cincinnati, Hamilton and Dayton Railroad system, in consequence of rumors that in the reorganization of the securities of all of the roads. The holders of a majority of the 44 per cent. Cincinnati, Hamilton and Dayton stock have organized a committee to protect their interests.

WHEAT FALLS AWAY; CORN GOES WITH IT. Wheat prices fell away in the early market to-day, following a break in Chicago. Corn started steady, but later declined with wheat. The following closing prices were: Wheat—May, \$1.75; December, \$1.75.
