

# BIG LINER WAS ASHORE OFF SANDY HOOK

Weimar with 1,600 Immigrants Aboard Stuck in Mud Nine Hours.

While the North German Lloyd liner Weimar, from Mediterranean ports, was feeling her way into port through Swash Channel in the dense fog this morning she ran aground on the south edge of Flynn's knoll, off the point of Sandy Hook. The vessel carries 1,600 immigrants.

Swash Channel, through which vessels enter New York harbor, is a narrow waterway and in the fog that prevailed it would have been easy for the Weimar's pilot to have missed his course and run the vessel on the Hook knoll. The Weimar, which is one of the older boats of the company, carried 1,600 passengers.

## MINERS REFUSE TO ARBITRATE WAGE SCALE.

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind., April 20.—The International Executive Board of the United Mine Workers of America today rejected the proposition of the operators of Western Pennsylvania, Illinois, Indiana and Ohio, who are opposing the payment of the 1906 wage scale to coal miners, and who, through J. H. Winter, their chairman, offered to submit the differences to arbitration.

## SIXTH INSURANCE BILL IS NOW A LAW.

ALBANY, April 20.—Gov. Higgins today signed a sixth of the special insurance committee's bills, that amend the penal code as to more effectively penalize falsification of the books and records of a corporation. This leaves one pending in his hands and two more pending in the Legislature.

## RAILROAD MEN GUILTY OF GRANTING REBATES.

CHICAGO, April 20.—The Chicago Exhibition and Quince Railroad, Durbin Miller and Claude G. Birmingham, officials of the road, were found guilty today in the Federal Court of granting rebates in violation of law. The railroad corporation was fined \$10,000 and the two officials \$10,000 each.


