

# BOY ABANDONED OUT WEST SAYS HE IS A NEW YORKER

Tells Story of Being Placed on Train by His Father, Named Carstead, but Declares His Name Is Willis.

BOONVILLE, Mo., June 8.—A bright little chap of five, believed to be the son of some New York family of wealth and possibly to have been kidnapped, is the centre of sympathetic interest here. The conductor of the Missouri, Kansas and Texas Flyer handed the youngster over to T. F. Walz, the station agent here, with the statement that the boy had been placed in his care at San Antonio, Tex., by a man who said that relatives would meet him at Boonville. No relatives have appeared, and it is obvious that the boy has been abandoned.

The small wanderer is well dressed, and has a suit case filled with fine clothing. While he says that his name is Willis Harris, he adds, peculiarly, that his father—the man who deserted him at San Antonio—is named William Carstead. He tells of living in New York with "Aunt Lizzie," but has no idea of where his home was there.

The boy says that he has been living for some time at Torreon, Mexico, with his father, and was taken from there to San Antonio.

Boy's Deserter Was a Stranger in San Antonio.

SAN ANTONIO, June 8.—William Harris, the boy placed on the train here

Sunday evening and abandoned, has neither relatives nor home in this city. The man who placed him on the train was a stranger to the ticket agent.

The police believe that the "Aunt Lizzie" mentioned in the despatches is Mrs. Lizzie Harris, employed as housekeeper for Mrs. Shook at No. 233 West One Hundred and Thirty-second street. Mrs. Harris says she is convinced the boy found in Boone, Mo., is her nephew, William Harris, five years old.

Mrs. Harris called at Police Headquarters after she had read of the finding of the boy. She said that she brought him from Ireland when his parents died four years ago. Her daughter, she said, was married to Alexander Carstan, mining engineer of Leadville, Col. They were in New York a couple of months ago when they went South and asked for permission to take the boy with them. She granted this, and the last time she saw little William he was about to be taken to Durango, Mex. About five weeks ago Mrs. Harris received a letter from her son-in-law saying he was going to send little William back.

"I suppose they put him on the wrong train," said Mrs. Harris.

The police will communicate with the police in Boonville and have the boy sent on here.




